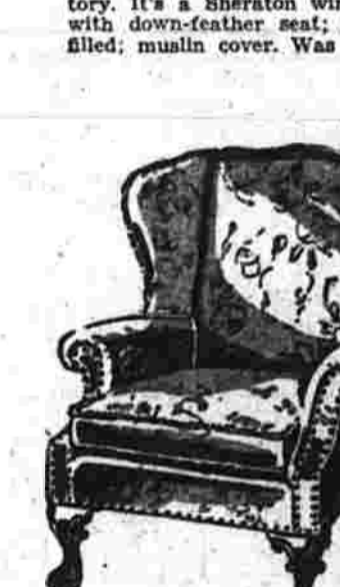
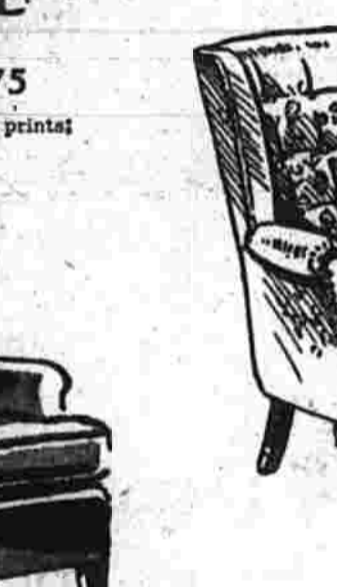

Minister Mixes Magic With Religion To Emphasize Points in His Sermons

 (Special to The Herald) — It is a skeptic tells Rev. Ted V. Voorhees, pastor of the Carnegie Methodist Church, that he does not believe in the Biblical miracles, because he doesn't understand them. Voorhees has a counter-claim.

Standing in the pulpit, Voorhees takes an empty cylinder and magically produces yeast after yeast of cloth. A competent semi-professional magician, he completely mystifies the congregation.

"I can do this," he tells the skeptic, "and you do not understand what must God be able to do with his omnipotent powers."

Thirty years ago, Voorhees saw himself perform. He was so enchanted by the matter doing, that he talked about doing the trick himself. When his wife questioned his ability in magical directions, Voorhees became even more determined and taught himself to do this.

For the last 27 years, he has been practicing magic from the pulpit. He has recruited several hundred young ministers of all denominations to this theory of teaching faith in God through magic.

Voorhees believes that "one way to religious thinking is through magic. I tell the story of Jesus providing the multitude by the bread and fish, a single loaf and a single fish."

And, with a mysterious stunt, he takes a piece of paper money and proceeds to multiply it. The "multiplying bill" trick, he illustrates the point to the congregation particularly the children who love his magical sermons.

Voorhees performs for many local clubs and organizations and has written books on the use of magic in churches. He has known famous magicians personally at the local chapter of the International Brotherhood of Magicians.

Despite the fact that the Methodist Church no longer requires it, Voorhees continues to wear the clerical collar. He believes a minister should be really recognized as such.

Besides his interest in magic, Voorhees is also a student of psychology. He is a certified psychological examiner for Pennsylvania public schools, and is working for his doctor's degree in the subject.

Beirut, Lebanon — (AP)—The American University of Beirut has set up a "little Marshall plan" for students among Arab Palestine refugees. The heads of this oldest U. S. educational institution in the Middle East started an educational program last year based on the principle governing the European Recovery Plan—helping people to help themselves.

Applicants—who were to receive free education plus allowance for sustenance—were carefully screened, since the funds were limited. Priority was given to students closest to graduation when the war started.

During the 1948-49 school year, the University extended assistance to 234 Palestinian refugee students. University heads are hopeful that their appeals for the program during the coming year will raise enough money to cover expenses and expand the number of students receiving help.

Rome—(AP)—Scientists have discovered the ruins of a Roman town in a lagoon on the North Adriatic Sea. A group headed by Mario Fontana, an authority on Roman and early medieval archeology, may have found the ruins of a legendary town, "Syracusa," in the lagoon shallow waters, during the last centuries of our era.

When the Hunns headed by King Attila swept across the Alps to the Italian plains, the population of the towns of Aquileia and Bithone fled for their lives. Attila destroyed Aquileia and maybe also Bithone. The inhabitants of the two towns had fled. Part went to Grado in the lagoon north of Trieste and the remainder fled by boat. They were shown by heavy northwestern Adriatic winds to the site on which Venice was founded.

Of the old town of Bithone only the legend remained. After weeks of searching the bottom of the canals of the lagoon in front of the little town of Marano, Fontana, wearing a light diving suit, discovered a wide stone bank with a monumental stairway leading into a greater depth. It may have been the basement of a Roman temple, Fontana said.
