Tumble Taken By Egg Prices

Poultrymen Expect Federal Government to Announce New Price

Hartford, Oct. 27—(AP)—Egg prices took a tumble in the past week, that the Federal government, poultrymen said, was expected momentarily today to announce a new support price to stabilize the market.

In a week the Boston wholesale market on large eggs dropped 18 cents to an overnight quotation of 48 cents a dozen, biggest drop in years. This was the lowest since OPA controls went off in 1946. The Connecticut price reflects these changes with prices here about one or two cents higher.

Good Consumer Buys Available Egg men emphasized that good consumer buys are available as a result of the situation caused by the fact that new flocks are starting to lay earlier than usual. The Federal support price is higher in some cases than the wholesale market figure.
