The first class meeting will be held Wednesday evening, November 2, from 7:30 to 10. Robert W. Bruce will be the instructor in charge.

The group will with the aid of the instructor determine weekly assignments and the program requires regular attendance for at least 200 hours a year of class instruction. The instructor also visits and supervises the farming of each enrolled veteran at the farm for not less than 50 to 100 hours yearly.

Institutional on-farm training is designed to help veterans make progress with their farming.
