**Report Made On Building**

33 New Dwelling Permits, Valued at \$315,575 Issued in Month

A total of 33 new dwelling permits, with construction costs estimated at \$315,575, have been issued in the month of October.

Of the total number of homes, 15 were single units, 14 were duplexes and 4 were townhouses.

Two state and commercial structures were permitted, both on Main street in the Army vicinity. One was 16,500 and the other for \$45,000.

Twelve garages were authorized for a total of 88,000. Miscellaneous structures permitted are not at \$14,497.

Alterations and additions were 37 in number, valued at \$21,153, making the month's total building figure stand at \$471,237 for a total permit income of \$847.

### Manchester's Newest Block Adds to Beauty of Sector

Manchester's Main street now has a beautifully modern block containing over 300,000 cubic feet of usable space—the new Jarvis block which houses the new and greatly expanded Woolworth store and the new business office of the Southern New England Telephone Company. Not only is this block completely modern in appearance, but it is fully air conditioned as well as incorporating the latest and best in modern design, but it adds greatly to the overall appearance of Main street. It balances to a large degree the unimproved look of the street and architecturally speaking it is a building which the town people might rightly feel adds much to the town.

The Jarvis block is the largest mercantile building to be constructed on Main street in more than two decades. It is 120 feet long and compresses the basement and two stories above ground. It has a steel frame with concrete floor joist and poured concrete slab flooring. All exterior walls are finished with a gray-white face brick and second floor windows are all steel sash.

**Passenger Elevator**  
Perhaps one of the features of this new block that will come in for most favorable comment is the passenger elevator in the lobby facing Main street, and adjacent to the Telephone Company lobby. Stairs to the second floor are to the rear of the elevator. The building has a freight elevator which surely will welcome to occupants of the upper stories. There are two separate stair wells, one for the Woolworth Company and the other for the occupants of the building. The construction of this building involved difficult excavation and shoring in the rear of wall, as at this point the excavation had to go down about 30 feet and gravel with a two-family house sitting right on the bank of the excavation all the time. By using steel sheet piling and wooden plank the bank was held, the house did not move and a substantial concrete wall was put in that now sustains the wall of the building and holds the bank of earth too.

**Large Block Rooms**  
The basement about two-thirds of the floor space is given over to the Woolworth store. This is a model of efficiency with row after row of new steel shelving for storage purposes. The balance of the basement is used for a cooler room, air conditioning equipment, toilet facilities, power and telephone cable, heating, meter boards, etc., and several storage rooms. The office to be used by the Telephone Company has a separate storage basement under it, completely cut off from the remainder of the basement. There are exits from the basement to the first floor and the outside at both the front and rear.

The floors and walls of these rooms have been tiled throughout with a most attractive shade of light green hard glass tile. The tile will resist undue wear throughout the years and present no problem in keeping the rooms spotlessly clean. Separate offices, rest rooms and toilet facilities for the Woolworth Company have been provided in the rear or west end of the building which are fully removed from the remainder of the building. Other tenants and people in the building will not have access to the Woolworth offices but two emergency exits from the Woolworth offices have been provided which operate only one way.

### Reduce Deaths By Drowning

**State Police Credited For Leadership in Cutting Such Mishaps**  
Hartford, November 9.—Charging that the State Police today credited the State Police Department with leadership in reducing deaths by drowning from 76 cases for the first nine months of 1949 to 54 for the same period this year. Reduction of 28 cases or 37 per cent indicates 1949 may be the lowest year in Connecticut's history of vital statistics for deaths by drowning, he said.

### Records Show Disease Drop

Hartford, Nov. 9.—The occurrence, prevalence, spread and final control of many communicable diseases in Connecticut during the past 20 years is shown by the increase in demand for laboratory diagnostic work, said E. Evelyn West, Chief, Division of Diagnostic Microbiology in the November Connecticut Health Bulletin.

For example, examination of specimens for diphtheria, glandular, malaria, pneumonia, rabies and typhoid appear on the records in 1918. By 1948, there were considerably fewer or no specimens for these diseases and most of the laboratory work done on them was for preventive purposes.

Inspection of Conditions at 91 Plantations in State Are Conducted
