

9 1/2 Billion 'Card Passes' To Figure Insurance Melon

Washington (NEA)—In business terminology a "card pass" is a card which is used to record performance on one card by one business machine. It will take 9,250,000,000 such card passes to figure out the dividends which veterans get next January on their GI insurance.

The payment of \$2.8 billion worth of dividends to 16,000,000 war veterans is the biggest, most staggering single bookkeeping job of its kind in history. More than 2,500 specially-trained business machine operators and clerks are working night and day on the job in a group of temporary buildings in the shadow of the Lincoln Memorial.

To the great relief of the officials who have been planning the job, the actual work is running smoothly and slightly ahead of schedule.

The very size of the job creates some complicated problems which have to be solved by the business machine operators. Edward G. Joseph, a government insurance expert from St. Louis who is in charge of the job, admits that even he is having difficulty with the details of all the computations.

Here are some facts and figures which give an inkling of the size of the operation:

The master alphabetical file of approximately 621,000 veterans named Smith will get refunded there are 524,000 "Smiths" in the first four cards in the file for veterans.

"Aaaa" The last name in the file is "Zzzzzzzz" of which there are only one. However, these figures apply only to the initial batch of 10,000,000 applications which have been received. Dividends for 3,000,000 to 10,000,000 policies have not been received yet.

Since the job started a few weeks ago 700,000 basic changes have had to be made on the machine because of such things as death and change of address. A "basic" change is one that affects the size of the final dividend and to whom and where it is to be sent.

Never before has there been so much change in the data on a machine which is to be used to compute the final dividend. There are being rented from the International Business Machines Corp. 100,000 machines which will be used to keep the job day and night to keep the machine working.

Hundreds of different make machine operations are required on each dividend application card.

To Give Talk To Educators

Governor Bowles to Deliver Address at New Britain Meet

New Britain, Dec. 1—Governor Chester Bowles will address the afternoon session of the conference of the Connecticut Association of Boards of Education at Teachers College, New Britain, Friday.

Dr. Roger H. Motten of Westfield, president of the association, announced discussion will be held on such topics as whether junior college grades should be added to school programs; whether the state should set up a ready high school graduate; and if new school buildings should differ from that built a decade ago.

Other topics deal with better relations with finance boards, the press, the P. T. A. and the public in general; proper steps in developing a school building program; and group understanding and for home and family living, whether regional schools should be developed for maladjusted pupils; and whether good outside work experience can accompany a formal school program.

Special Demonstration
Roger B. Lead of Hartford, Program Chairman and former president of the association, announced that a special demonstration teaching techniques will be given by students and faculty of Teachers College and that developments in school building planning will be illustrated by N. Searle Light of the State Department of Education. The discussion group leaders will include Mrs. H. Otis Howarth of Greenwich, State President of the P. T. A., Friedrich G. Roth of Bridgeport, State President of the C. M. A., and Mrs. Harold Strickland of Middletown, President of the Women's Federation of American Farm Bureaus.

A panel on Educational Opportunities will be led by Sigmond Adler of the Rocky Hill Board of Education. Other panelists include Community State Cooperation, John B. Lyman of the Middletown Board of Education and Chairman of the State Board of Education; Marion S. Dimmock of the New Britain Board, and Our Schools Look Ahead, Professor Wilbert Snow of the Middletown Town Board Education. Among other participating in the conference are Dr. Flint R.

Operation Performed Here Inside the Chest Cavity

Modern anesthetic methods now allow certain operations to be performed inside the chest cavity.

A patient was recently discharged from the Manchester Memorial hospital who benefited from such an operation. The hospital first became acquainted with this patient several months ago when he was admitted because of bleeding from a stomach ulcer. Conservative methods failed to stop the bleeding and an emergency operation was performed to control it. The patient was of the rare blood type known as RH negative. Six transfusions were necessary to replace the blood lost and an appeal was sent out for RH negative donors. Manchester citizens have always responded to these appeals and they did so in this case.

Since the establishment of the hospital blood bank, blood has always been available for emergency cases and a significant number of lives have been saved. Instances such as this one put a strain on the bank but it has never been liquidated.

The patient, however, later developed another ulcer for which

Defense Will Open Today

Clarke Charged With Misappropriating Sum Of \$54,707

New Haven, Dec. 1—(AP)—The defense was scheduled today to begin its case before Superior Court Judge Samuel Melitz in the embezzlement trial of Richard H. Clarke, 51, of Washington, D. C. Clarke is charged with misappropriating \$54,707 from the Boardley-Crest Corp., of which he was general manager, and which was organized in March, 1948, for the purpose of developing a Trumbull housing project.

He was arrested Dec. 10, 1948, on the complaint of Mrs. Jeanette Boardley Thompson of Shelton who with three members of her family were officers and members of the corporation.

Mrs. Thompson made her complaint to State Attorney Abraham S. Ullman who obtained the warrant for Clarke's arrest.

State Close Case
The state closed its case yesterday after introducing in evidence a statement allegedly made by Clarke that he had used between \$14,000 and \$18,000 of the corporation's money.

The statement, Ullman said, was made to State Police Sgt. Leo P. Carroll who arrested Clarke. Attorney Thomas R. Robinson, Clarke's counsel, made no objection to the admission of the statement, but asked for an adjournment until today, after Ullman rested his case.

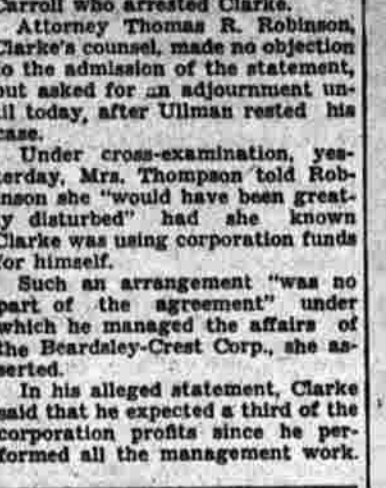
Under cross-examination, yesterday, Mrs. Thompson told Robinson she "would have been greatly disturbed" had she known Clarke was using corporation funds for himself.

Public Urged To Study Case

A & P Says Success of Civil Action Will Increase Food Prices

Recent statements by Government anti-trust lawyers on the case against the Great Atlantic & Pacific Tea Company are reprinted in company advertisements published this week in 2,500 newspapers.

Under the bold heading, "Don't Let Anybody Fool You!", the ads state that success of the civil action will destroy A & P, raise the cost of food and increase the likelihood of similar attacks on other chain stores.

The company states that anti-trust lawyers are "trying" by court decision to impose a new kind of economic policy on the people of this country. If they succeed in destroying A & P, they will have destroyed the method of distribution that has helped make the American standard of living the envy of the world, it the ad states.

The A & P arguments are directed against claims made by anti-trust representatives in speeches, letters and news articles. The Washington lawyers said that the suit would mean a single A & P store, will result in lower food prices and will only affect A & P.

Would Break Up Organization
The A & P points out that the court is being asked to "break up" A & P's retail stores into seven regions, each of which must be sold to different owners, and operated under new management and to "order" us to sell in our factories, which produce many of the fine foods you find in our stores, to still other new owners.

"None of the present owners, who have made A & P what it is today, can have anything to do with either the store or the factories," the ad continues. "No one can predict what the policies of the new owners of the various parts of A & P will be. Nor, despite the anti-trust lawyer's statement, can anyone tell how many A & P stores will remain open or will close. So, while there may be a food store where your A & P is now located, it won't be your A & P store. Make no mistake about it. If the anti-trust lawyers win their suit, it will mean the end of A & P as you know it."

Company Gives Reasons
The company also reasons why the suit would result in higher food prices instead of lower costs. "The Government lawyers claim that the very heart of the anti-trust lawyer's case is that A & P's methods, which they claim are legal, have enabled the company to undersell competitors. How can anyone possibly say that you will get lower food prices by eliminating the company that has done so much to bring them down?"

"The ad goes on to explain that the suit would make A & P get rid of its manufacturing facilities which enable it to pass savings along to consumers in the form of lower prices. "Make no mistake about it," the ad states. "If the anti-trust lawyers succeed in putting A & P out of business, you will find your food bill higher."

In refutation of the Government's claim that only the A & P will be affected, the ad points out that the suit can be used as a basis for an attack against other grocers and merchants in other lines. "If A & P is destroyed," according to the company, "no business-man could safely turn to a more progressive sales policy designed to lower prices and give his customer a better deal if by so doing he takes business away from any competitor."

The company's statement concludes by saying, "Even if an anti-trust prosecuting officer, or a decision against A & P will establish a precedent that could be used by the present anti-trust lawyers, or any future anti-trust lawyer, to destroy any efficient business that buys cheaply, sells cheaply and grows big in the process."
