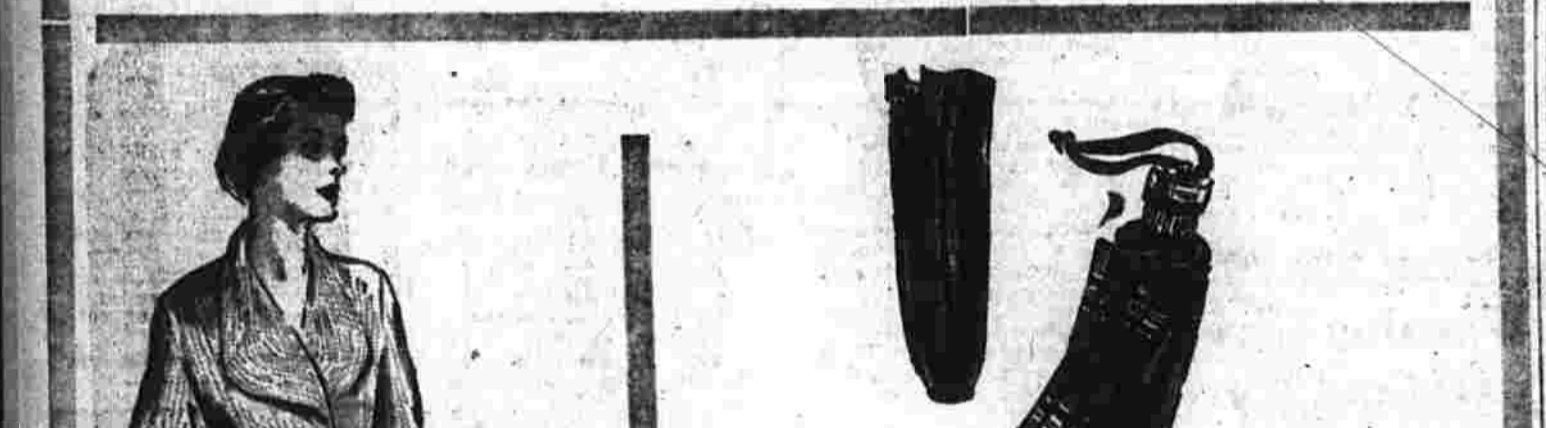

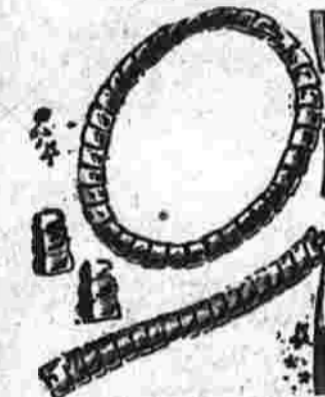

### Sees Approval Of China Reds

#### Diplomatic Recognition Of New Government Is Expected Soon

By Charles Beach  
Washington—The United States is watching a small step against the Communist Chinese government by failing to recognize it. But a high diplomatic authority says non-recognition can't last forever.

In the long run, he says, the withholding of recognition is not a powerful lever. It is recognition that gives prestige and strength to a new government, but once other governments have accorded recognition, a nod from the U. S. would mean so much more.

By withholding recognition at this time, the U. S. hopes to make it clear to the Chinese Reds that it does not intend to fulfill its international obligation. The Reds' mistreatment of Angus Ward and other Americans.

Secretary of State Acheson has said, the Chinese Communist government is not only live up to their international obligations. They also must control their whole country, and the Chinese people must at least acquiesce in their rule.

For recognition the American government has required that the new government must control the territory they are recognized. Thomas Jefferson first formulated the viewpoint that recognition doesn't mean approval—only that the U. S. acknowledges existence of the government.

It is recognition of a set of facts, nothing more," says Secretary of State Acheson. "We may not like the facts, but we must recognize them if they have come into being. We may deplore their attitude toward other liberties. Yet our long-range objectives in the promotion of democracy and peace may be best served by recognizing it and thus maintaining a channel of communication with the country involved."

Recognition of a new government has advantages for both sides. That's the reason some other countries are reported to be recognizing the Chinese Reds as soon as possible. It opens the channels of diplomatic intercourse. Before recognition, envoys of foreign powers have no legitimate status. They are treated like private citizens and can be of only limited use to the government they represent. If an envoy of a country you are interested in turns up in your country, you can't do much for him as an alien citizen in your country.

An unrecognized government can't be prosecuted before international tribunals in case it fails to live up to treaties and other obligations. One government doesn't have access to the courts of another nation unless it is recognized. It couldn't sue to enforce contracts and to obtain damages for confiscation of property. Under such circumstances, a government finds it hard to make treaties and to write contracts for purchases.

The authority to recognize a new government rests with the President. This has been standard procedure for many years, although at times it has been argued that the power was held jointly by the President and Congress.

At any rate Congress must acquiesce.

Quebec Village Sits on Ore
Burr Creek Located on One of Richest Iron Ore Deposits in Canada

Burr Creek, Quebec—(NPA)—This settlement of several hundred people on the Quebec-Labrador border will have to move pretty soon. It's sitting directly on top of one of the richest deposits of iron ore in Canada.

Burr Creek is the hub of activity, exploring and preparing what has become known as the Uggava deposit. Altogether, more than 2000 square miles of rugged country about midway between the Gulf of St. Lawrence and St. John's Strait are being searched by private companies who are gambling that the area will some day reveal Minnesota's Mesabi Range.

An estimated \$7,000,000 have been poured into the project by mining companies. The work was speeded by World War II, which threatened to exhaust the tremendous Mesabi Range deposits, and by the discovery that Uggava ore averaged as high as 60 per cent natural iron, with the average 58.5 per cent, compared to Mesabi's 51.5 per cent.

Canada, of course, wanting scarce American dollars, is encouraging the work. The Dominion also has a building steel industry in the Province of Nova Scotia, and iron from native mines would make the Nova Scotia steel mills bloom.

The history of the Uggava region's iron bonanza goes back to 1893 when the Geological Survey of Canada noted the presence of ore in the region. At that time, however, the ore was inaccessible and not vitally needed.

Seven Islands will need \$10,000,000 for giant ore docks. Incidentally, the American city most likely to benefit from Uggava is Boston, which is 1000 miles by sea from Seven Islands and may become a huge ore port.

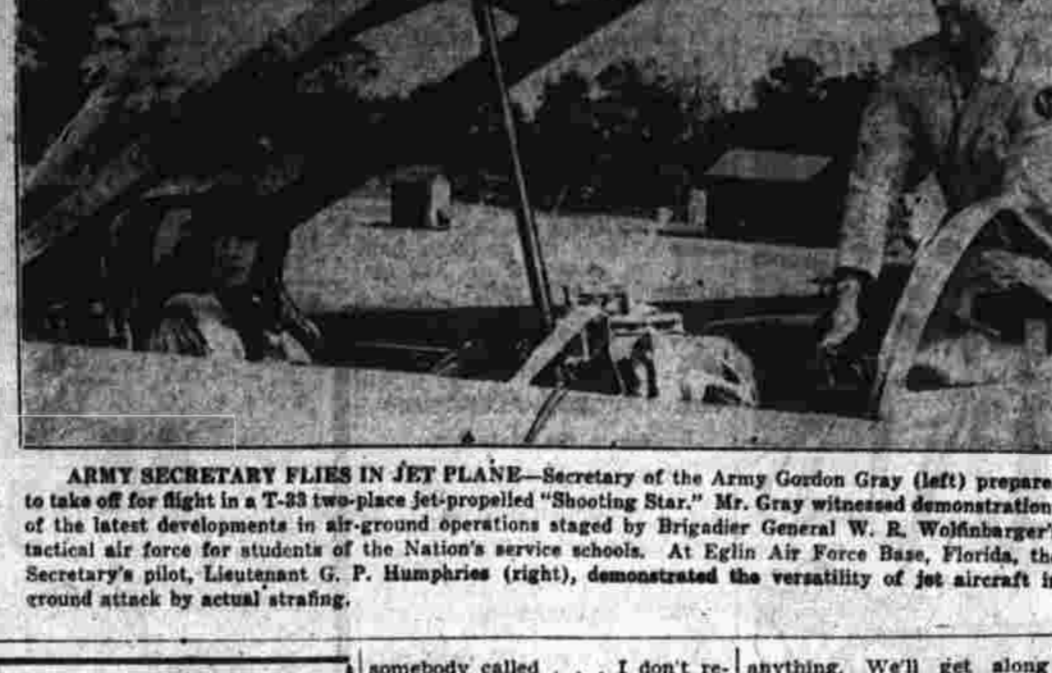
