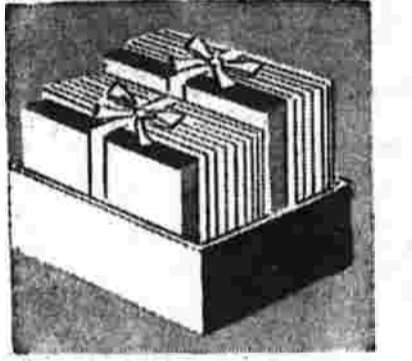

America's Stake in Europe Is on Long Time Basis, Rep. Ribicoff Declares

Last of six articles by Rep. Abraham A. Ribicoff (D., Conn.) of Hartford, based on his observations during a tour of Western European countries this summer as an official observer for the House Foreign Affairs Committee of which he is a member. His contact with world statesmen and his personal observations have been crystallized by the Congress in this series of articles.

Washington, Dec. 10.—Europe will never again have the political and economic balance which was hers during the 19th century. The past few years have seen the disappearance, as such, of two military and naval powers, Germany and Japan, and the eclipse of a third, Italy. It has witnessed the serious economic and military depletion of two Western powers, England and France. The recovery of these former strengths is by no means assured. It has been a century since the world has seen the American flag flying over the European continent, and for a year, to the Atlantic. Further, the United States has extended its orbit into vast portions of Eastern Asia.

In the same period the United States has involuntarily entered into the pre-eminent position of power among Western nations. This pre-eminence is inherent and cannot be abdicated. It is doubtful that history gives us a precise example of such a shift in the power situation in so short a period. Such shifts in power do not take themselves to task. The adjustment is necessarily prolonged over many decades. The economic and security problems of Europe—and this nation—will not be over in a year or two. They will continue to challenge our wisest thoughts and best efforts for many years to come. But our thinking will not be wise nor our striving adequate if we cling to the illusion that the situation is a transient one or that we can turn our backs upon it any time we wish and, at most, in just a few years.

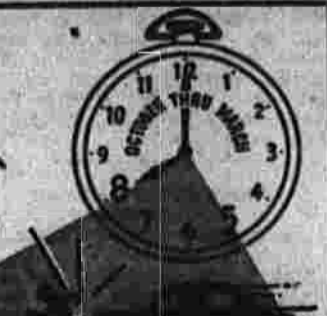

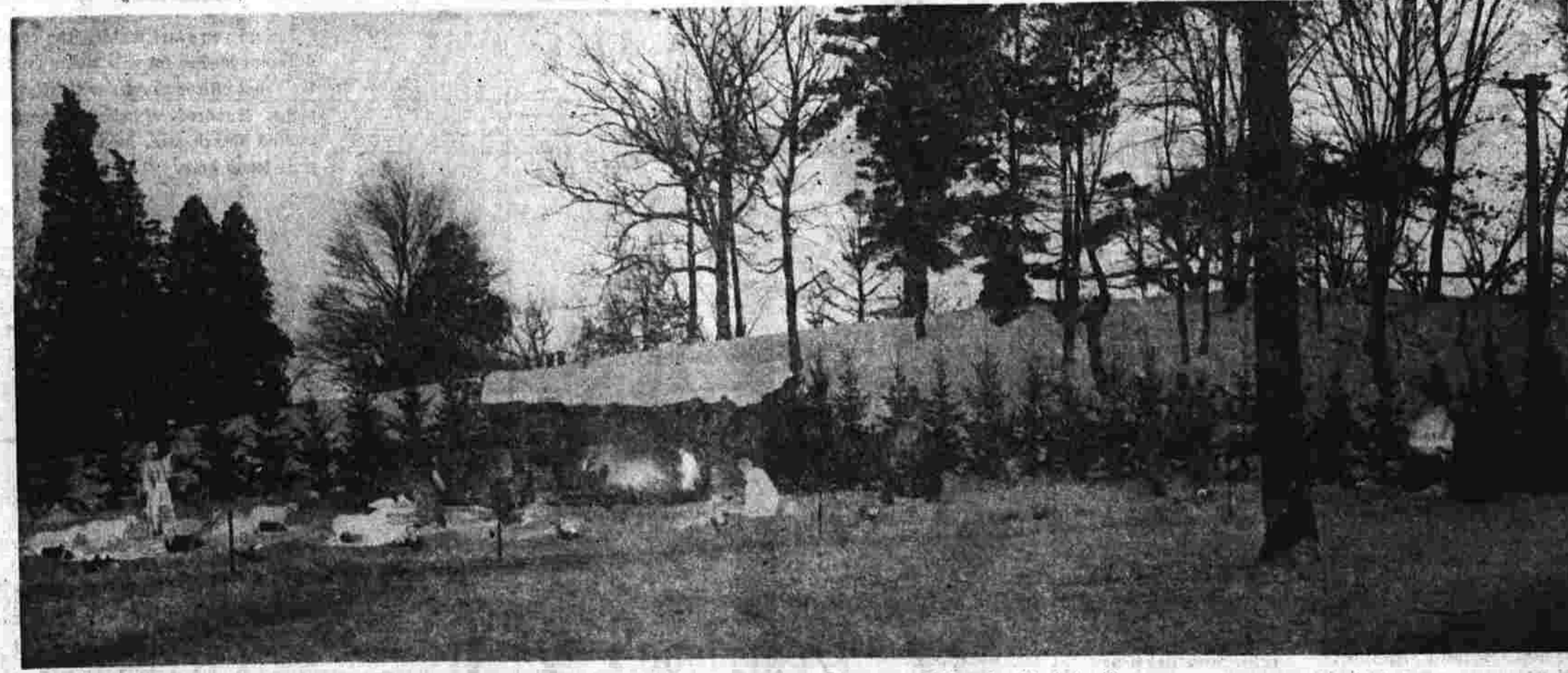
