175-pound son told her when she asked him yesterday if she killed the girl.

"I must have. I was the only one in the room. I don't know how it happened because my mind is a blank."

Sheriff Albert J. Murphy said he was holding a diary found in Bednasek's room. He said the diary would say it, but it was written "in abbreviations" and could be interpreted "unless he (Bednasek) will interpret it to us."

During the fall trial interview Bednasek spoke incoherently at times and appeared on the verge of tears.

Bednasek recalled little of events in the second floor room where he went for police.

"I just remember lying on the floor," he said. "I picked her up. I guess I remember much about it—just talking to her—though she had passed out. I tried to wake her up. Then I sat down. I guess, made me sense something was wrong—all this."

Both had drinks.

Bednasek said Margaret had told him many times she loved him and that she could never marry with the present but she loved him Saturday night she loved him.

The girl's body was found clad in a strapless white evening gown which she is known as the "Rampy Arms."

State, county and local authorities said in a statement that the sequence of events leading up to the girl's death was as follows:

Bednasek reserved the room and took Miss Jackson there about 7:45 p.m. on Saturday night.

Later they went to the Sigma Xi chapter of the Psi Chi fraternity winter room.

Bednasek is a member of the Psi Chi fraternity.

Bednasek did not remember another thing after that until he fell into a deep sleep on the floor, not breathing.

He ran to a police station around the corner and shouted there was a girl in the rooming house who isn't breathing and I need help.

Returning to the rooming house, police said, Bednasek buried a whiskey bottle out a window.

Reports circulated in Iowa City that the girl had been playing "blackout," a game in which less of consciousness is sought by holding the breath and pressing nerves in the neck.

Coroner Callahan, however, said he had found no evidence to substantiate these reports.

The Connecticut State Housing Authority's \$30,000,000 Home Ownership program is progressing at a most satisfactory rate. More than 1,800 applications for certification as eligible to apply for a state mortgage loan have been received. These applications are being processed as rapidly as possible and the authority expects to begin returning certificates of eligibility next week.

Requirements for eligibility include a total gross income of not more than \$2,000 a year, plus \$600 for each dependent; a net cash worth of less than \$2,000, and inadequate housing for the family at present.

Questions as to details of rules for qualifying for a state loan continue to puzzle many applicants. A set of questions and answers on the Home Ownership program have the approval of FHA.
