Sofia, Bulgaria, Dec. 17.—The government proclaimed today that former Deputy Premier Traicho Kostov in the last days before he was hanged confessed he was guilty of treason. The report said he had vainly appealed to the government for mercy. Kostov and 10 others were convicted last Wednesday as plotters and spies, aiming to turn Bulgaria into a vassal state of Marshal Tito's Yugoslavia. Only Kostov was sentenced to death.
