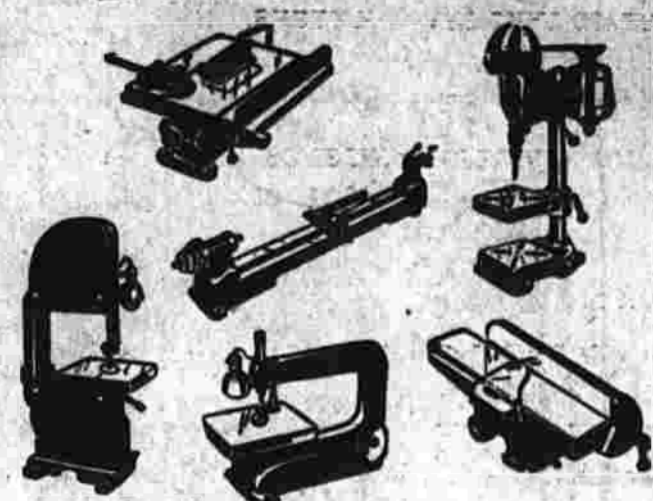

Peaceful Federalism Out
 A real live debate on the question of federalism is going on in the committee of the Council of Europe, organized at Strasbourg, last summer. One of these committees is now meeting again at Strasbourg, trying to seek ways of carrying out the Council Assembly's vote to seek real but limited European federal unity. This committee, the only federal union to be formed in a very real, immediate, and practical sense. What comes out of it will be a preliminary test of the possibilities of applying the federal principle to selected groupings of nations.

Short Of Dollars Too
 The line-up in the Council of Europe committee on the federal union is clear. The nations like France, Italy, Turkey and Greece are ready for a referendum now. Britain is the nation which is opposing the idea of the creation of any supra-national authority. There are two reasons why Britain is opposed to the idea, and each illustrates what we think will be the result of a referendum. One reason is the economic effort to pull itself up by its own bootstraps, has created a special planned economy which it is trying to keep insulated from important influences from outside. The more important reason, however, is the fact that Britain is the only nation in the world which is a member of the British Commonwealth of Nations, which extends around the world, and whose other members would not be eligible for membership in the new European federation. Were Britain to join a European federation, Britain would thus have split loyalties and obligations to the European federation, and also still to the Commonwealth. Britain can't see her way clear to such a division of responsibility and to the fact. Just to make the argument good, Britain throws in the thought that such a European federation would also establish right loyalties for all its members, but that federation and the already existing United Nations. What is the answer? It is, we think, simply this: that the principle of federalism cannot establish itself in any limited sectional way. No European federation can amount to much without Britain. But Britain cannot join any federation to which her fellow Commonwealth nations are not admitted. Therefore any European federation, to have a chance of success, must include such nations as India, Pakistan, South Africa, and Canada. In other words, any European federation will have to be a world-wide federation. And that is the truth, as the Strasbourg debate is illustrating.

The Peaceful Stalin
 Researchers can find Stalin talking both ways about the possibility of capitalism and communism living peacefully together in the same world. He can be found saying that possibility, and he can be found accepting and advocating it.

Yesterday, the Russian newspaper, article written for the celebration of Stalin's birthday by Khrushchev, generally considered the strongest man in Russia, said that Stalin himself, chose to emphasize those remarks of Stalin which have conceded the possibility of peace, and denied the possibility of armed conflict. And it is true, on the record, that the great majority of Stalin's public statements since the war have been on that side of the fence.

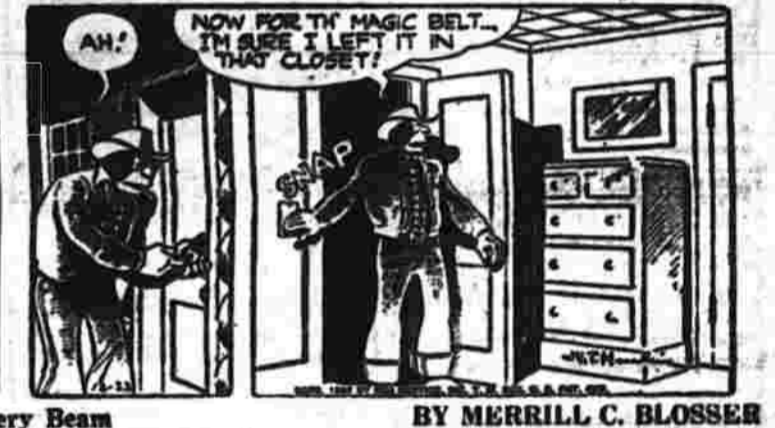
