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**New Hearing Device Has No Receiver**  
 Boston In Ear  
 Chicago, Ill.—Doctors here are using a new device that gives them clear hearing without a receiver button in the ear. They now enjoy songs, sermons, business companionship and friendly conversation with an ear-ear device that people are looking at with interest. The device is a thin, translucent plastic disc that fits snugly in the ear that it is used in. Sound is relayed to it by an electromagnetic coil from a button concealed in the clothing of the speaker. The disc is held in place by a thin wire that is attached to the ear. The disc is made of a special material that is not affected by moisture and is easy to clean. It is used in both ears and is worn for several hours a day. The device is used in many places, including hospitals, schools, and homes. It is a great help for people who have hearing difficulties.
