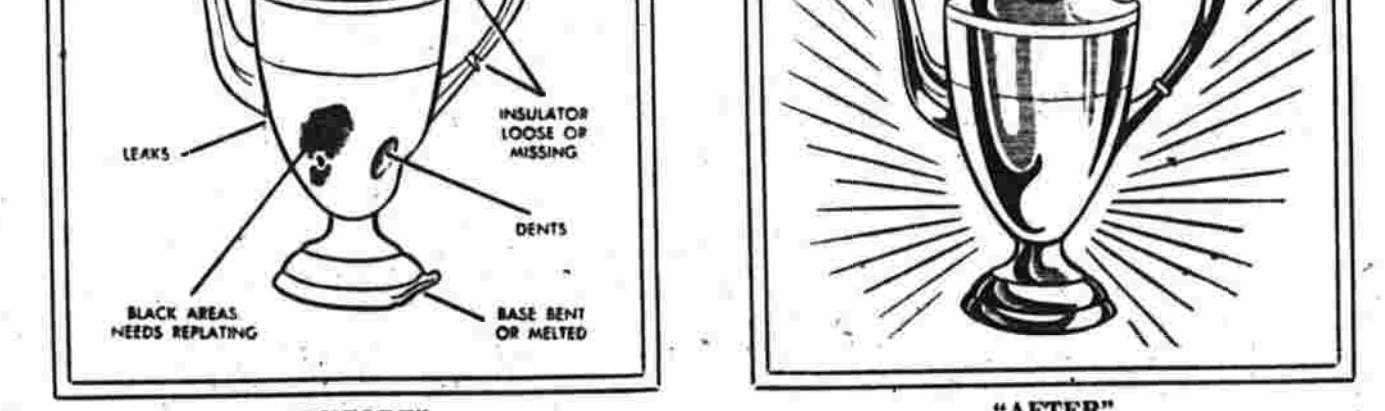

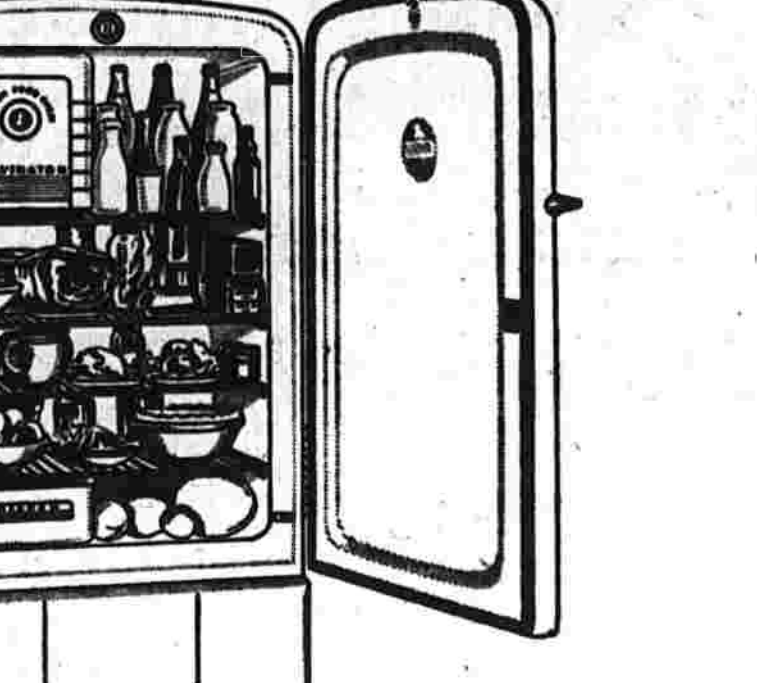

Chilean Social Worker Ends Her Studies Here

Has Been in United States Four Months, Most of It at Cheney Mill; Her Impressions

Miss Maria Luisa Chabrat, a social worker from Chile, brings to a close today a four-month visit, most of which has been spent in Manchester and the Cheney Brothers' factory plant, studying the employment of women in the United States.

In an interview this morning, Miss Chabrat related some of her experiences as a social worker, her reasons for being in this country and what knowledge she has gained about women employment here in contrast to her own country.

Here on Grant she was awarded a training grant by the Women's Bureau, U. S. Department of Labor, for four months study of the employment of women in the United States, of their working conditions, of labor legislation affecting them, of health standards and counseling services in factories and other work establishments; of the education, health and recreation programs of labor organizations; of women's participation in union activities; of community facilities for women workers, especially provisions for the care of children of working mothers.

Extensive safety measures, which Miss Chabrat enforces, have been established by the company. She deals with various problems of the employees and their families, works with the doctor and nurse, and sees that the employees report for the annual medical examination which is required as part of the preventive medical program.

All factories have a union that is associated with the Federation of Unions in Chile. Ten per cent of the factory profits must be turned over to the union funds and

Relations between the unions and labor with employers is very good and there seldom is a strike. Miss Chabrat resides in Vina del Mar, a city with a population of 300,000. The area was once the farm of a very rich family and is a beautiful residential city. Zoning regulations are very strict. When building a home, plans must be presented to the city officials for inspection. No home can be built without having enough area for three garages and the homes must be well planned or they will be rejected.

When she first came to Manchester, Miss Chabrat wanted to see the homes of Cheney employees. She was amazed that there was no housing project to keep employees residing in the same area and marveled at how Manchester was situated. Her tour here has included trips through the capitol in Hartford where she sat in during a session of the legislature. The office staff at Cheney Brothers' Employment office have taken her to many spots of interest in this vicinity and last night she visited Hillier College. As a guest in some homes she has seen the home life of Americans and was pleased with what she saw.

Miss Chabrat leaves tonight for Washington, D. C. and will then return to her home country. 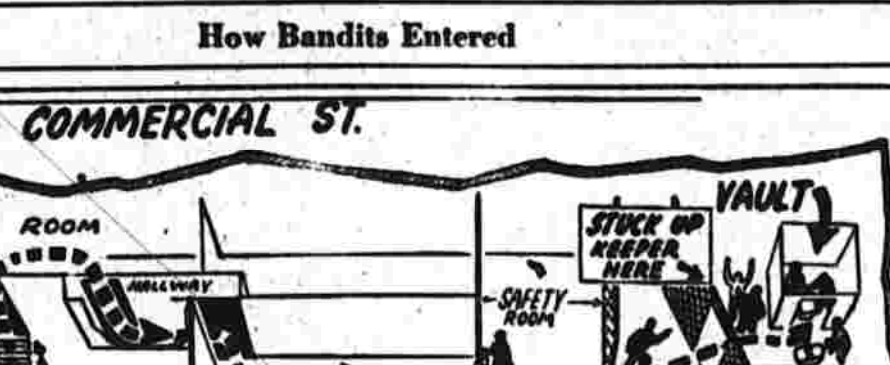
