The following Maple street pupils assisted in filling the boxes: Raymond Cox, Robert Tart, Dolores Hudson, Elvia Plesch, Henry Byczynski, Barbara Struthers. In addition to thanking the children for the Polish children, we also ask the pupils to write to them. The letter is as follows: "Our Dear Sisters: The Junior Red Cross children of our school hurry to thank you for the gifts you sent us. Just today we've had a meeting and letter in which we divide the gifts among our members who are in need of the articles. Our school unit of the J.R.C. members over seventy. We live in the southeastern part of Poland in a village named Wadowice Dolne. Four years ago all of us fled from our homes with our families because the Russian-German front lines were passing through our village. They fought here only six months. After they had gone away we returned to our destroyed and burned homes to begin our lives. It was very hard because we had nothing to begin with. After getting help from our government, the U.N.R.R.A. and other organizations we had to begin a new life. It's still hard but we hope that your letter will get to be better than the last one. Write us how you live, what you, your parents do, about your work, the J.R.C., etc. If possible write in Polish if not, write in English. Send for you all our best regards. We're signing off. Your Red Cross friends from Poland."

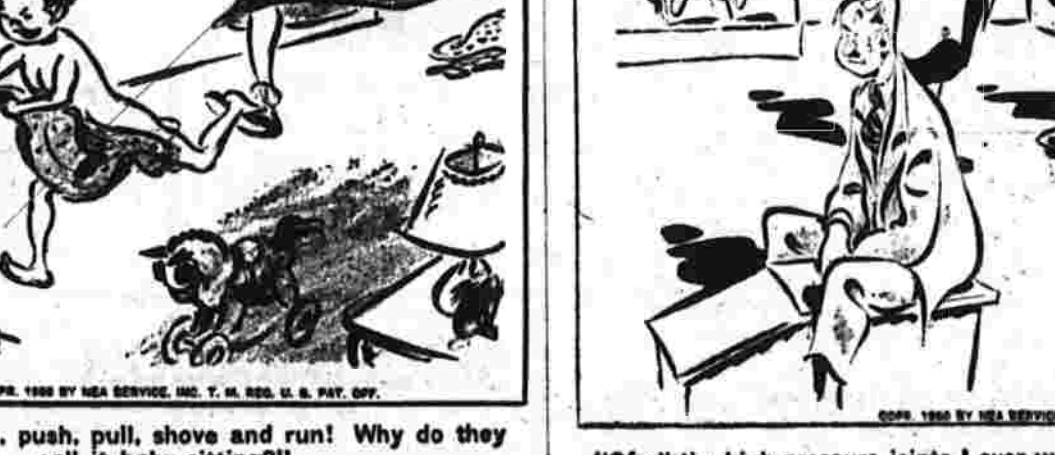
