Dr. A. N. Geiger, president of the Connecticut Heart Association and associate clinical professor of Laddonia at Yale Medical School, was presented to the Manchester Heart Drive Committee last night at the library of Manchester Memorial hospital. ### Speeding Tops Law Violations

Hartford, Feb. 1.—(AP)—Connecticut's traffic law enforcement program rolled along unabated today with state police reporting 369 arrests and 22 licenses picked up since Saturday morning.

Though traffic was slowed down by Tuesday's snow and sleet storms, state police reported 48 arrests yesterday, with four motorist licenses taken away for violations of major motor vehicle laws. Of the latter, one was charged with "driving after drinking" and three with reckless driving.

Capt. Ralph J. Buckley, head of the State Police Traffic division, said speeding still topped the list of traffic law violations. More than 100 were arrested on that charge, while 48 were arrested for reckless driving and 16 for drunk driving. The remainder comprised charges of violation of rules of the road, failure to grant way of way, passing stop signs and signals, and others.

### The Doctor Says

#### Treatment of a Birthmark Depends on Variety, Location

There is a common superstition that birthmarks come because of an unfortunate incident occurring to the mother during pregnancy. The claim that when a baby is born with a strawberry mark the mother had an uncontrollable desire for strawberries cannot be proved. Some birthmarks are attributed to a fright of the mother. All of these ideas are not true and do not stand up when carefully studied.

Fortunately, birthmarks are usually so small, except in the case of a large one, that they do not cause any concern. Occasionally, large ones appear on the face or some other conspicuous part of the body where they are unsightly. It would like to know more about it.

Some birthmarks are made up of numerous tiny blood vessels in the skin. Some are red and some are brown. Some are level with the surface of the skin but some are raised. Some are dark purple color which gives them the common name of "strawberry" birthmarks.

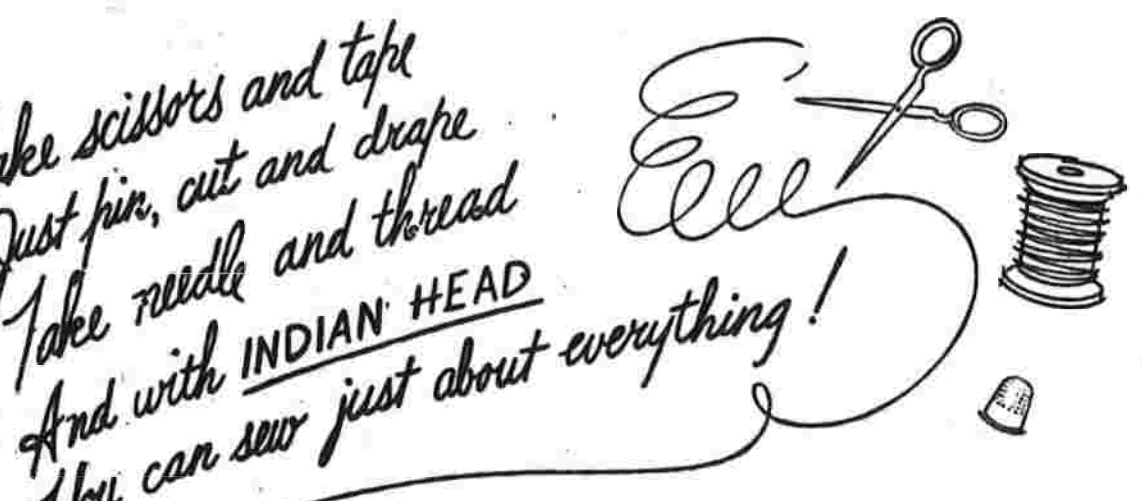
