**Petition Sent On Federation**

**17 Yale Law School Faculty Members Voice Approval in Telegram**  
New Haven, Feb. 2.—Seventeen Yale University Law School faculty members today voiced their approval of world federation in a petition to Connecticut's senators and representatives in Congress.

Dean Wesley A. Sturges and 16 associates have wired the Connecticut members of Congress asking them to back House Concurrent Resolution No. 64 and Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 36, both of which call on the U. S. to strengthen the UN and "seek its development into a world federation."

The telegram, from the Law School faculty members, stated that their full support of this resolution is given as a result of the establishment of the rule of world law.

HCR-64 is supported by Reps. John Davis Lodge (R.), Abraham Ribicoff (D.) and Charles G. Woodhouse (D.), while Senator Brian McMahon has also expressed his favor of HCR-56. In 1948 the voters of Connecticut favored, 11 to 1, a world federation referendum.

In addition to Dean Sturges, who is a member of the National Advisory Board of the United World Federalists, the Yale Law School petition was signed by the following faculty members: John H. Thompson, Vera Courtney, Ralph S. Brown, Jr., Harry Shuman, Harry L. Hiltner, George D. Braden, Harold D. Laskov, Fred Hodel, Friedrich Kessler, Fleming James, Samuel E. Thorpe, Thomas L. Emerson, Foster W. Harper, Moses R. McDougal, George H. Deason, and Elias Clark.
