He was booked as Earl Raddala, 28, an unemployed laundry worker, and charged with breaking and entering, forgery and theft of automobile. He is being held without bond for further investigation.

Detective Sgt. Henry Nevins said an unidentified FBI agent and two local detectives arrested Raddala last night.

On October 31, Raddala presented an allegedly worthless check for \$400 to a grocery store. He was arrested, receiving \$100 money at the time. Raddala agreed to wait for the other \$100 until he was able to raise the money.

In the meantime, Scitamaunch National Bank was notified of the check and turned it over to police who, falling to trace Raddala, decided to arrest anyone who collected the \$100.

On Feb. 2, Raddala was arrested and, upon being questioned, admitted, police said, a series of some 10 burglaries in which jewelry, silverware and furs were taken.

Captain of Detectives William J. Lynch said he has disclosed an estimated \$10,000 in loot, mostly jewelry, silverware and furs, estimated in both cellar and attic.

Lynch also mentioned two automobiles which Lynch said had been reported stolen and which he believed were in the hands of other in New York City.
