same superiority we thought we had when we had the atomic bomb alone. That superiority of ours was based on monopoly. There is now no monopoly, merely a race between two world scientific and industrial groupings. We can no longer threaten to use atomic weapons without getting back the threat that atomic weapons will be used against us.

We can no longer think of delivering atomic bombs without receiving them in our turn. We can no longer extend to the people ranged on our side the assurance that they are protected by our monopoly.

Along with the end of our monopoly has gone, although our military minds practically refuse to admit it, our theory that we could erect a military containment line against Russian Communism. The Truman Doctrine is dead, not only because we have lost the military superiority on which it was based in theory, but also because we have found that there is not enough armament in all the world to halt Communism in some area like China.

In the demise of the Truman Doctrine, there has come a realization that we must oppose Communism not with arms, but with good works with high moral ideals, and with practical missionary work in behalf of the welfare of the people whose favor Communism is also seeking. This has been the only real way in which we have ever had a chance of halting Communism. It still is inevitable as the Truman Doctrine is in the present world context of armament race. It will be an unhealthy influence upon our foreign policy if it leads any Americans to think that we have, by our intention of making it, regained any military kind of domination of the world. It will weaken us, rather than strengthen us, if it leads any of us to think that it in itself represents any solution of our world difficulties.

The decision to manufacture the hydrogen bomb at all is so negative that it makes no change whatsoever in our world situation. Even on the purely military side, all it guarantees is that our military situation will become no worse. Actually, it still leaves us essentially as we were before the decision was announced—with the Truman Doctrine dead, and our great need of putting flesh on our skeletal activity into the other more sound resources we have in the world test between two ways of life.

Truman Doctrine Still Dead

If one considers what seems the very evident truth—that this nation would not now be embarking upon the manufacture of the hydrogen bomb if it had not been for the fact that Russia developed and exploded the A-bomb last summer—it becomes apparent that what we hope to gain from the hydrogen bomb is a restoration of that atomic superiority we felt before we knew Russia had the bomb.

We think of the hydrogen bomb as something that may once more give us the lead in the atomic weapons race. We think of it as something which may once more give us the military "drop" on Russia.

In this theory, we once more stand outside the world, promising to stop Russia by our own atomic military might.

But the truth is that the hydrogen bomb does not restore the

Five Persons Die by Violence Over Week-End in Connecticut

 Five persons died by violence over the week-end in Connecticut and three of them raised to 34 the number of traffic fatalities since Jan. 1.

In addition to the three traffic deaths, one man was shot to death on an Ansonia street and a 10-year-old boy drowned while skating on the Bethel reservoir.

Shot fatally early Sunday morning as he emerged from a automobile on Liberty street, Ansonia, was Dominick Maniacello, 39, an ex-convict who had served portion of a state's prison term for the Spanish high school in Ansonia three days more than three years ago.

Blast Death Brings Suit

Arkansas Woman Seeking \$186,420 Damages as Fatality Result

New Haven, Feb. 6.—(AP) —The United States District Court clerk's office reported today that Mrs. Martha S. Trischmann of Little Rock, Ark., has filed suit against the Ensign-Bickford Co. for damages for the death of her husband, J. Werner Trischmann. The complaint says Trischmann was killed in a dynamite blast at his lime quarry in Choctaw county, Oklahoma, while using a fuse manufactured by Ensign-Bickford. The accident happened two years ago today.

Charger Equipment Detective Charging the Sinsbury company with selling her husband defective equipment, Mrs. Trischmann charged that the fuse was supposed to burn for two minutes but that the blast occurred immediately after Trischmann ignited the charge.

No date has been set for trial of the suit.

Kills Three Kin Before Suicide

Tampa, Fla., Feb. 6.—(AP) —Police have closed their books on the case of Anthony Stecha, and the three relatives he killed before driving the wheels of a heavy truck.

Detective Sgt. E. J. Roberts said the friendly New York bank clerk "just broke under the strain" of worrying for months about the health of his wife and her father. Stecha was 53.

The wife, Ann, 47, was found stabbed to death Saturday in her parents' home here. Also dead, and battered terribly, were her mother, Mrs. Peter Rudak, about 70, and sister, Ellen Rudak, 45.

Peace Justice J. C. Spivak, acting coroner, said "there is no question" Stecha killed the women and then jumped in front of the truck a block away.
