A description of the men, supplied by Mrs. Hansen, says a "very good type" by Patrolman George Jacobs of the East Hartford Police department resulted in the quick capture of the robbers.

On the lookout for the Manchester man, Jacobs picked him up late last night and turned him over to State Police.

Spector admitted taking part in the attack and implicated his companions, police stated.
