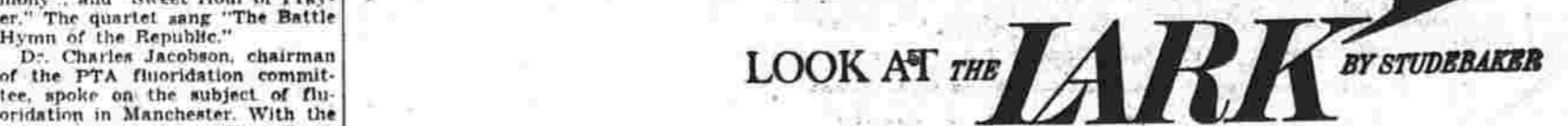

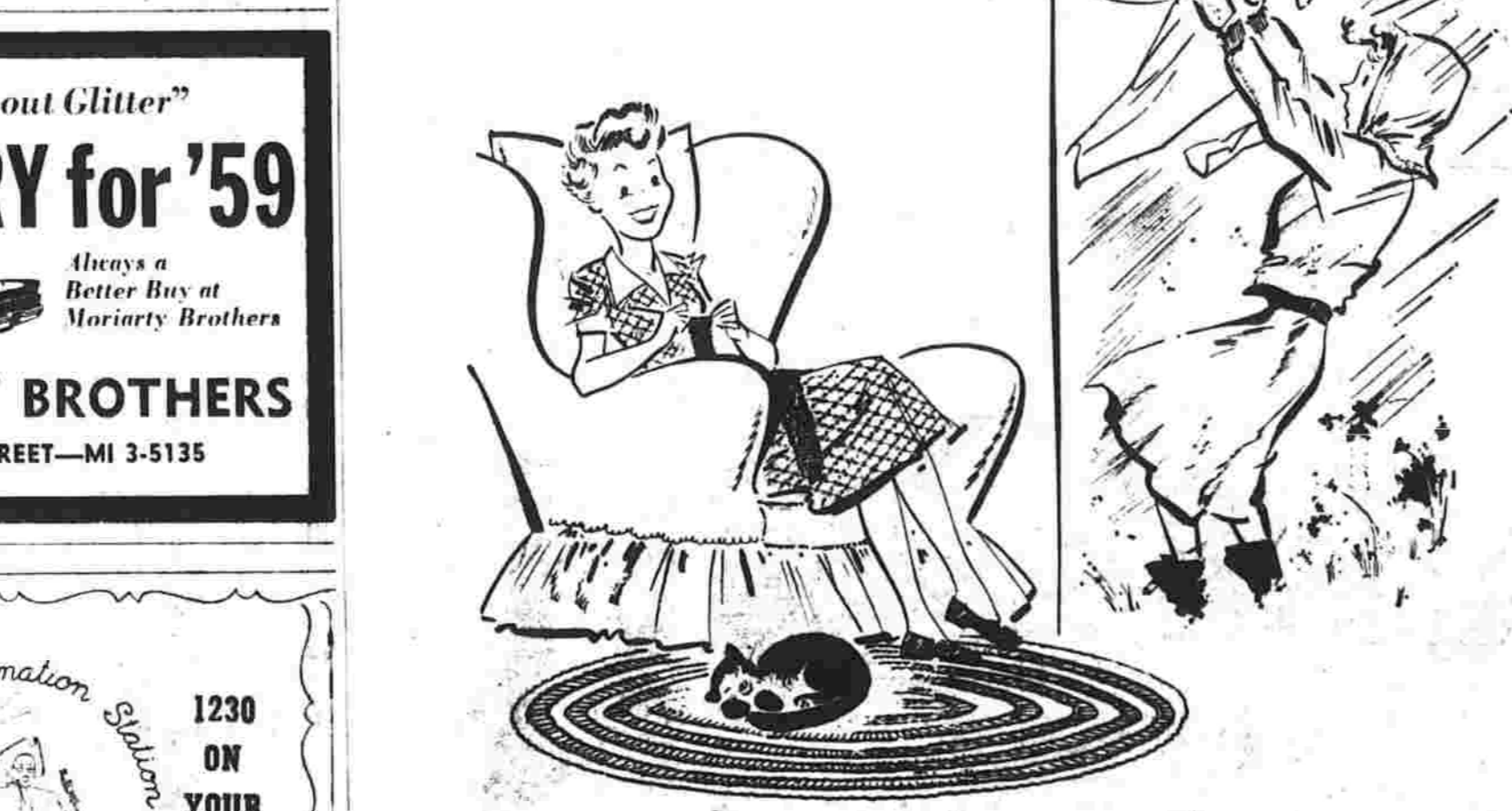

### Britain Bars Dr. Otto John

London, Feb. 11 (AP)—Dr. Otto John, ex-chief of West German security who went to jail for treason with the Communists, has been barred from Britain as an undesirable alien.

John was detained at Dover yesterday when he arrived from Belgium aboard a channel ferry. He was sent back today on the ferry's return trip.

John's wife lives in London. Friends in Bonn said he wanted to begin a new life as a lawyer in England.

John slipped into East Germany in 1954 and worked for the Communists. He returned to the West the following year claiming he had been kidnaped, but in 1956 the West German Supreme Court sentenced him to four years imprisonment. He was pardoned last July.

### Student Loans Now Available

Hartford, Feb. 11 (AP)—Three Connecticut teachers' colleges will get a total of \$11,879 in federal funds for student loan programs.

State Education Commissioner William J. Sanders said yesterday that the schools are the State Teachers' Colleges in New Haven, Willimantic and New Britain.

The New Haven institution will get \$5,616 from the federal government, Sanders said, while \$4,684 will go to the New Britain college and \$1,579 to Willimantic.

Under terms of the loan, students who will receive preference have superior academic backgrounds and who intend to teach in elementary or secondary schools. Students with superior ability in science, mathematics, engineering or a modern language also receive preferential consideration.

The maximum loan is \$1,000. The government will cancel half of a loan if the student engages in five years of full-time teaching in a public elementary or secondary school.
