Join in Saving Life of Child

Mongrel Dog and Keen-Eyed Engineer Share Credit in Episode

Willimantic, Feb. 14 — (AP) — A mongrel dog and a keen-eyed road engineer shared credit today for saving the life of two-year-old Jackie Green.

The youngster wandered from his home here yesterday and today along the railroad tracks 75 yards away.

Engineer S. A. Whyonoff, at the throttle of a Boston-Hartford passenger train, sighted the pair as he rounded a bend. The boy was trying to crawl on the tracks. The dog was tugging at his clothes in an attempt to keep him out of danger.
