# Joint Voting Seen Favored

A combined referendum on additional buildings and minority representation questions today was favored by a majority of voters, according to a poll conducted by the Manchester Evening Herald.

The poll, conducted by the newspaper's editorial board, showed that 65 per cent of the voters favored a joint referendum on the two questions, while 35 per cent favored separate referendums.

The questions to be voted on are: "Should the city of Manchester be authorized to issue bonds for the construction of additional buildings?" and "Should the city of Manchester be authorized to amend its charter to provide for the election of a minority representative to the city council?"

The poll was conducted by telephone interviews with 1,000 voters in the Manchester area.

# Shaping Plan Now To Stop Gambling

Mayor Thomas D'Alessandro of Baltimore, Md., is authorized to begin work at once on a series of recommendations for action by Congress to be submitted there by April 15.

The recommendations, which are being prepared by a committee of the House of Representatives, include a bill to prohibit the use of interstate highways for the transportation of gambling machines.

The bill would require the Interstate Commerce Commission to inspect all interstate highways for the presence of gambling machines and to report the results of its inspections to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

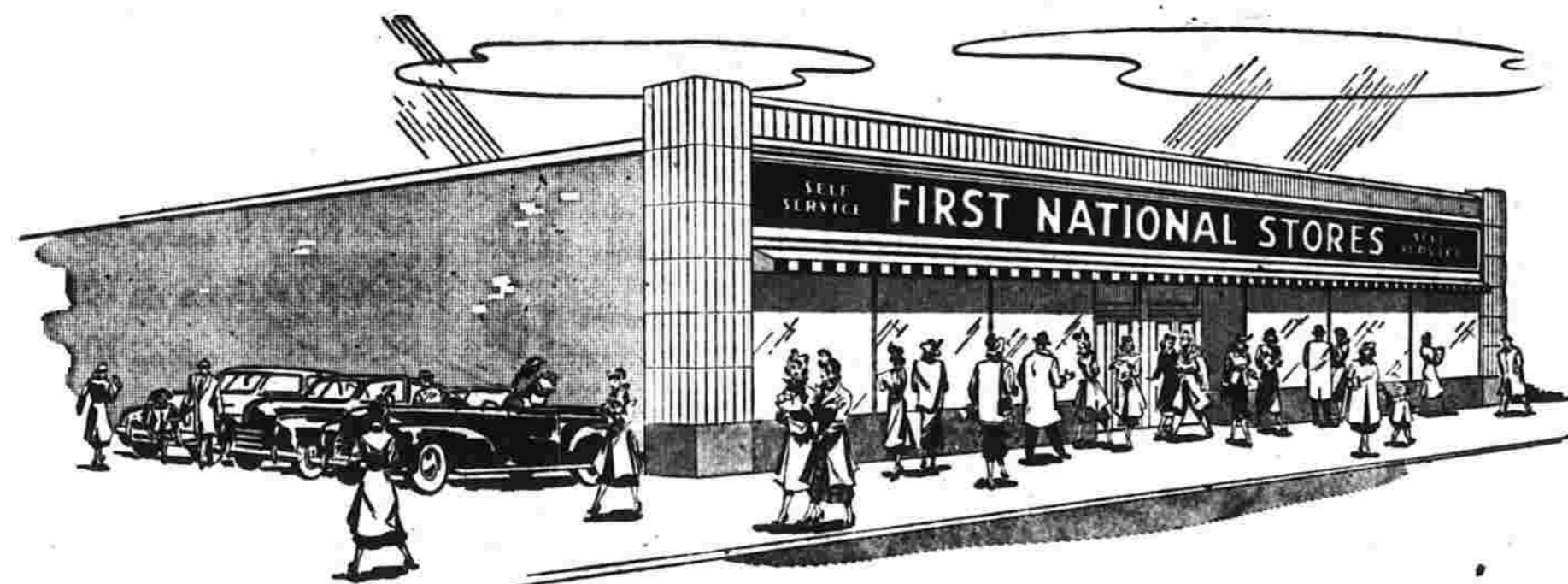

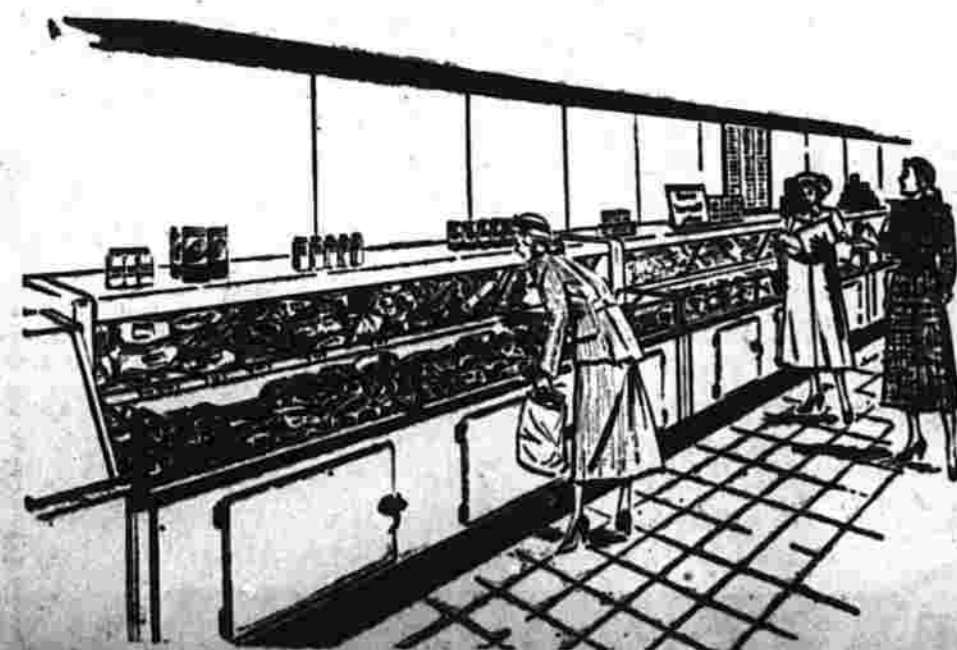

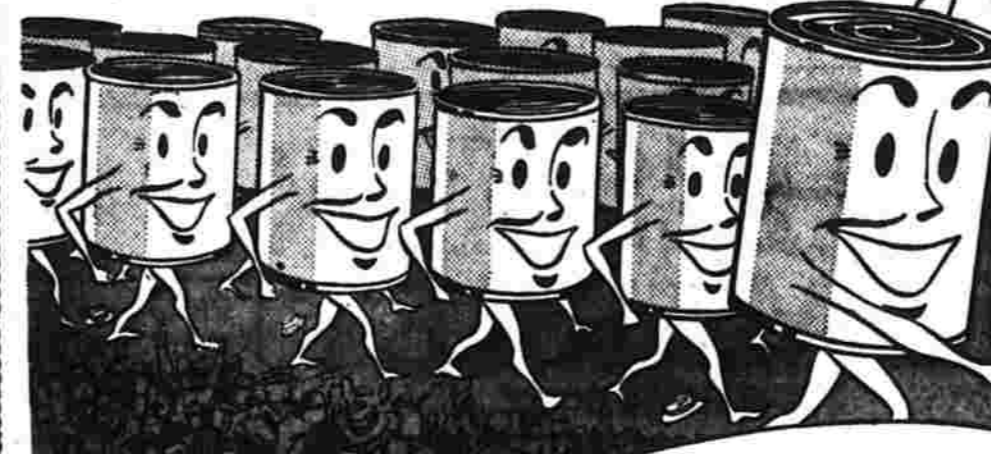
