To Seek Clarification On School Construction

Town School Building Committee to Secure Further Information From State

One of the first jobs that may face the Town School Building Committee as it again takes up the school construction problem here in the coming months may be that of securing further clarification of the requirements of the State Board of Education and the State School Building Commission as regards projected school structures for the town.

At Monday night's informal conference on schools, called by Chairman Charles S. House of the Board of Education, some feeling was expressed that the requirements are extreme, or have been interpreted as being much stricter than they actually are.

Mr. Holden's statement in this connection, as Mr. Star Holden, member of the Board of Education, stated, had concerned with state officials and had been referred to school buildings in other towns that had similar cases in ways that did not appear desirable to her, will seem to have met state requirements. She also noted that although it has been understood the state prefers one-story schools, a two-story brick and steel school is about to be erected in Falls Village.

Representative Sherwood G. Rowers said he considers some of the state terms "unreasonable" and thinks that in some instances the state has taken a "high handed and severe" attitude. He suggested the town go ahead and build what it desires, maintaining good construction practices, and then let the state "do what it wants" about it.

Tells of objections General Manager George H. Waddell reported that, even in the new schools Manchester is now completing, some objections were registered, and in the case of the plans for schools just turned down by public referendum, 19 objections were lodged on the East Center street plans and 31 modifications were suggested to the Hollister school by state agencies.
