Harry B. Mitchell, Chairman of the United States Civil Service Commission at Washington, today issued the following statement:

"A large part of the American public fails to realize that postmasters are civil service officials, appointed under the civil service system, and entitled to all the rights and privileges of the law.

"Postmasters were brought under the Federal civil service system in 1928. Every postmaster not only has to qualify for appointment through an examination given by the United States Civil Service Commission, but in the examination, he must be among the top three eligibles. After appointment, like other Federal workers, the postmaster serves without limitation on his term, subject to the same competent handling of his office, as is required of all other civil service employees.

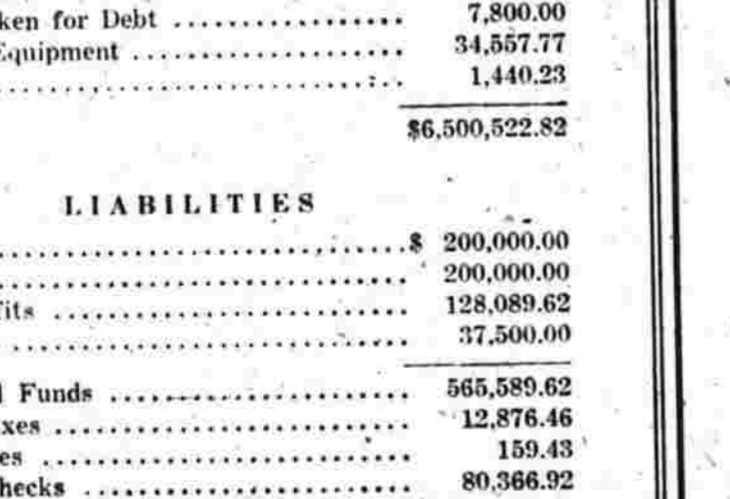
