Forty-Five Feared Dead In Skyliner Crash In Near East

Six Saved After Paris Bound Plane Plunges Into Persian Gulf; Infant Is Among the Missing; 6 Bodies Recovered by Fishing Boats; Air-Sea Rescue Units Scour Area

Paris, June 12.—(AP)—Air France said today "it is feared that all hope is lost" for all but six of the 51 passengers and crew of a C-54 Skyliner plane that crashed into the sea near Bahrain in the Persian Gulf last night.

Survivors include four men, a woman and a child, who were rescued by a fishing boat.

The bodies of four men and two women—all still unidentified—were recovered by fishing boats.

Infant Is Missing. Still missing are 30 persons, including an infant.

The plane was making a hop from Karachi, Pakistan, to Bahrain.

Company officials here said they still had no details of the accident.

A French Foreign Office spokesman today said he had received a message from the captain of the ship.

The company said Sladek had logged 15,500 hours of flying time.

Eight-member crew included a co-pilot, two radio operators, two mechanics, a hostess and a steward.

Air France said it was still hoped other survivors would be found.

The company said first news of the crash was received from Calcutta on Saturday.

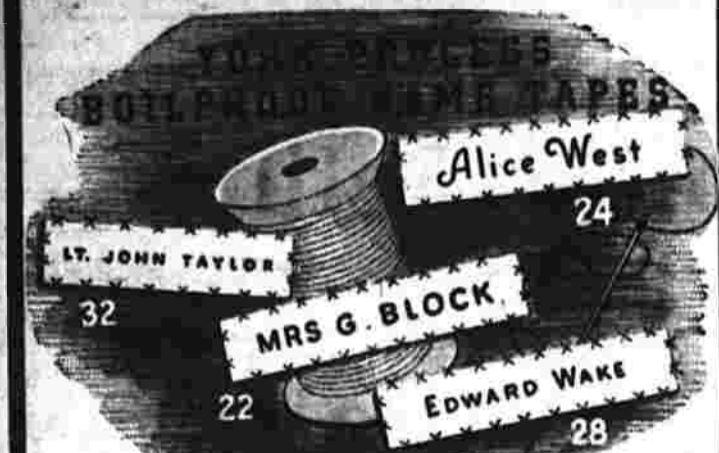

Progress of European recovery by a "go slow" attitude toward European integration, was expected to postpone debate on its stand toward the Schuman Plan until after the national elections in October. The statement, issued by the party's national executive committee, made plain that the Socialists fear merger with Europe may jeopardize their welfare as the program of full employment and mounting production through government planning. It expressed the party's traditional distrust of capitalist free enterprise. It also emphasized that in the Laborites European unity is not an overriding end in itself, that national sovereignty and Britain's obligations to her globe-girding colonies and dominions must come first.

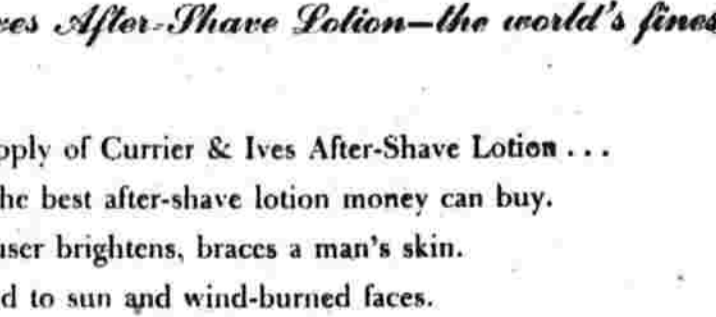
