Discuss First Phase Of Sewer Problem

Directors Study Plans For Enlargement of Otlett Street Plant and Engineers' Proposals

The Board of Directors last night discussed the proposed first phase enlargement of the town's sewage disposal plant on Otlett street, a project that may run to over \$100,000 in cost before it is completed. Preliminary plans and suggestions for the enlargement have been prepared by the engineering firm of Metcalf and Eddy. Several possibilities are open in regard to the treatment of sewage here, the least costly of which would be to enlarge present disposal facilities.

One plan called for the construction of a large conduit to carry sewage through East Hartford to the Connecticut River. Such a course of action, while possibly requiring only primary sewage treatment, was estimated to bear on the ultimate size of the

disposal plant to be provided. It has previously been estimated that such extensions, in all, may cost \$1,000,000.

The directors also received for informal approval the plans for the two new Jarvis developments, Hilliard Estates, at Middle Turnpike, west and Royal street, and Tremble Addition No. 1, the former for 120 units and the latter for 35 units.

Further negotiation for proposed water main installations adjacent to Jarvis property on Hartford road will be carried on by the

general manager, and he will also discuss with Alexander Jarvis the matter of extension of sewer mains in the Hartford road area west of Silver Lane Homes.

Uncollected Parking Tags Are Posing Local Problem

The recent publicity given the problem now faced by the Hartford Police department, which has on its books several thousand uncollected parking tickets, has raised some question here as to the status of the Manchester Police department in this respect.

Chief of Police Herman O. Schendel, when queried this morning, said that the local department has approximately 10 uncollected parking tickets on its books.

If a parking ticket remains unpaid within five to seven days after the tag has been issued, a letter is sent to the party calling the matter to his attention. If the ticket is still unpaid a week later another letter is sent, and then if after another week the ticket remains unpaid a warrant is issued for the person's arrest, Chief Schendel said.

He pointed out that the reason the first letter is sent out comparatively soon after the tag is issued is that the person will be able to prepare a defense if he feels he is innocent of the charge. If the letter or some other notification is not made until several weeks or months after the tag has been issued,

Slate Pearifoy Answer Today

The person to whom the ticket has been issued would probably have difficulty recalling the incident and, although he might be innocent, would be unable to prove it in court, Schendel said.

The inquiry group arranged to hear Pearifoy as:

1. Senator Tydings (D-Md.), the chairman, signed a recommendation calling for contempt proceedings against Philip Jaffe, one-time editor of the now-defunct American magazine. Three other members of the five-man committee said they plan to join Tydings in approving the recommendation by the group's counsel, Edward P. Morgan.

The move is based on Jaffe's refusal to answer questions about the five-year-old Amerasia case, which involved alleged theft during the war of hundreds of secret government papers. They were discovered in the New York headquarters of Amerasia by federal agents.

Jaffe pleaded guilty and was fined \$2,500 on a charge of conspiracy to obtain illegal possession of the documents. Last June 12 he went before the Senate inquiry committee which is reviewing the Amerasia case as part of its general investigation of McCarthy's charges. The department is harboring Communists and fellow travelers.

In recommending late yesterday that Jaffe be cited for contempt of Congress, Counsel Morgan told a news conference the former editor had declined to answer nearly all questions put to him, on the contempt ground that he might incriminate himself.

"In my opinion," said Morgan, "the privilege claimed by Jaffe under the fifth amendment was claimed on too broad a basis. A witness is privileged to refuse to answer only those questions which it reasonably appears might incriminate him."

If the full Foreign Relations committee and the Senate itself approves the contempt recommendation, it will go then to the Justice department for possible court action.

The subcommittee also has pending contempt recommendations against two other witnesses. They are Earl Browder, former chief of the American Communist party, and Frederick Vanderbilt Field, New York millionaire who has been charged with being a Red field spy.
