**Social Security Changes**  
Both Senate and House, in separate actions which should be easily reconciled, and by one-sided margins which demonstrated that there is no real argument about it, have enacted important changes in the social security law.

One change extends social security coverage to about 10,000 more people—the "self-employed domestic help, and other categories."

Another change practically doubles the rate of payment, to \$4,000 a month, for the "old-age security" coverage to about 10,000,000 people—the "self-employed domestic help, and other categories."

There is a doubling of the rate of payment for all cases in the future.

And another very sensible change included in both bills is the extension of the social security provision that any retired person still earning more than \$15 a month would have to forfeit his social security payments. That has, in the past, kept many retired people from part-time usefulness and a more pleasant mode of living.

All this is being presented to the public by handsome majorities in both houses of Congress. And so, in its extension of coverage and its change of regulations, it certainly is a landmark.

It has to be pointed out, however, that the increase in payments is actually not so much an increase as it is a restoration of the present scale of payments which was established in 1939, when the dollar was twice as much of a dollar as it is now.

There has been an interim of real hardship for those depending on social security. Those who paid in 1945 dollars and who have been receiving back 1950 dollars have been taking a beating. Their social security hasn't really contained the security it was supposed to. Inflation has been the villain.

What this illustrates is that social security, the desired goal cannot in itself be assured by social security measures alone, or by a formal scale of dollar payments alone. True social security also requires control of things like inflation. The scale of payments set up in the law has to be protected by a sound and stable national economy. When we fail to do this we actually rob Americans of benefits promised them and paid for by themselves.

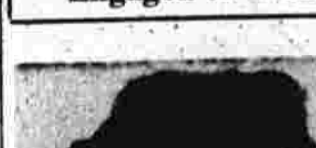
Police Lieutenants Raymond Griffin and Walter Cassella both testified that they had, prior to the raid, heard of gambling activities at the Grove.

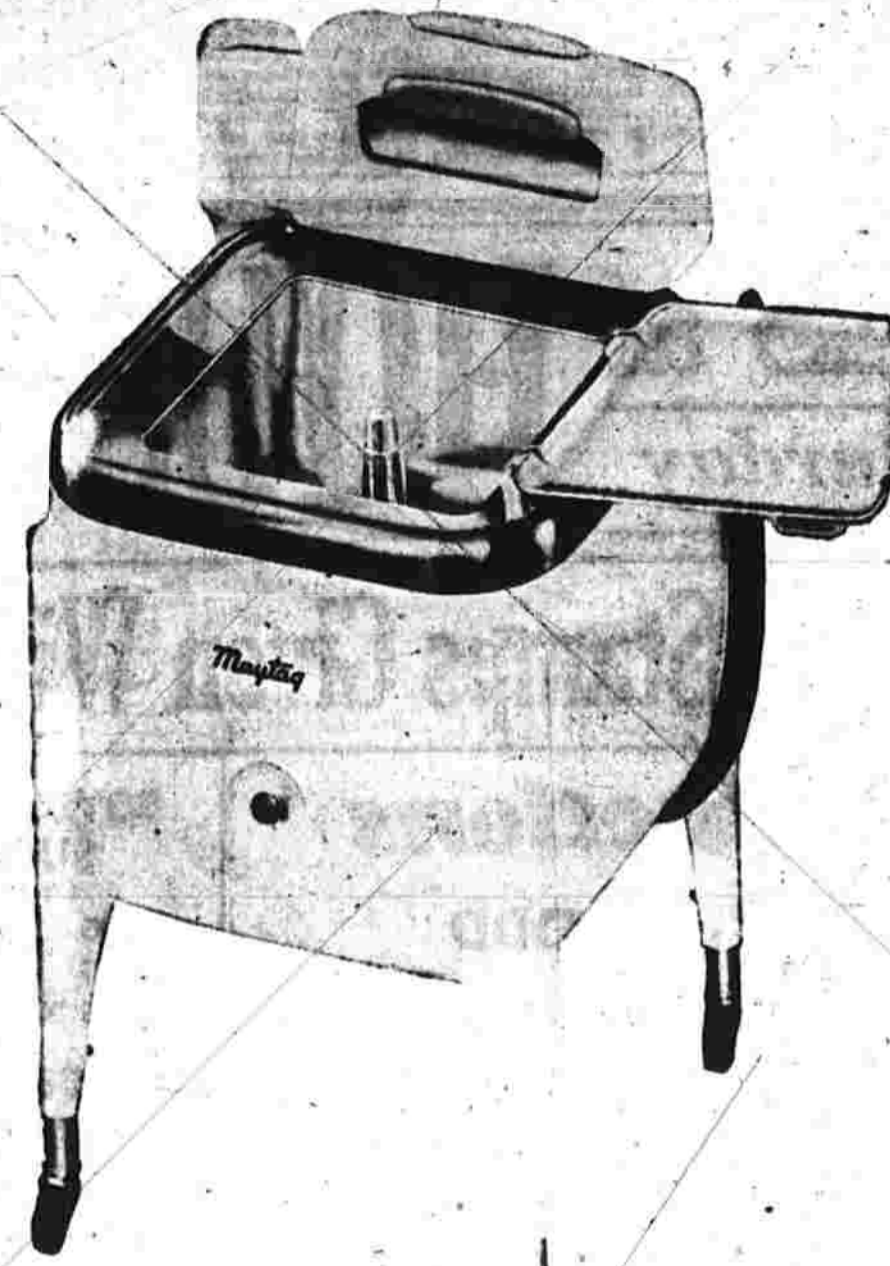

### British Homes Are Cold, Damp

Eastbourne, England — (AP) — A British expert admits that Britain has "the coldest, draftiest and dampest homes of any civilized nation." Donald V. H. Smith, a heating expert, owned up to what many foreign visitors have been saying for ages when he spoke to the housing section of the Royal Sanitary Institute.

"Americans think 69 degrees to be the best room temperature, Smith said most authorities agree that for Britain 63 to 64 is desirable in living rooms and 59 to 55 in bedrooms.

"These temperatures cannot be obtained by normal and traditional means," he said, "without a large consumption of solid fuel than the present restricted amounts."

### New Sprays Stop Nuisance Fruit

Washington — (AP) — Fruit on ornamental plants can be a nuisance. Among these are the horse chestnut, catalpa, European ash, honey locust and eastern poplar. Now the U. S. Bureau of Plant Industry says it has sprays which can prevent these plants from fruiting.

The bureau hopes also that such sprays may be used to limit the output on fruit producing plants to avoid the expense of thinning. In some crops, better fruit is produced if less is allowed to mature on one plant.

The fruit-retaining sprays are being developed by L. P. Butler, who did much of the work on the sprays which now help prevent losses of fruit which might otherwise fall off the plants.

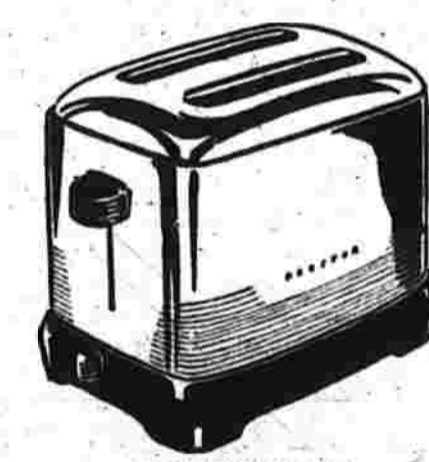

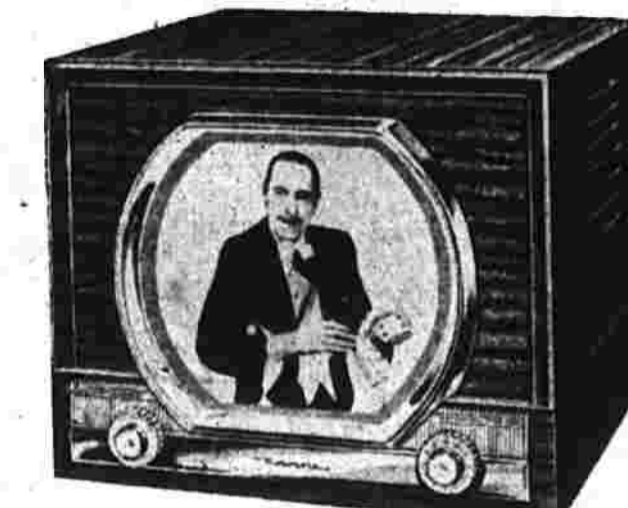

**Georgia Raising Fish Crickets**

Atlanta—(AP)—Crickets raising is a booming business in this part of the south. Fishermen say they make the bait. But wild crickets are sometimes as hard to catch as the fish.

Those who raise them sell them for bait at a cent and a half a dozen. Breeding stock brings two cents.

George Smith, for instance, has turned his backyard chicken house into a cricket raising business. He has 150,000 breeders and possibly has counted them. They eat laying mash just as chickens used to do. But the 16 bags a week he used to buy for his chickens would feed his crickets for 10 years.

**Malaya Iron Is Sent to Britain**

Singapore—(AP)—Malaya's largest iron mine has sent Britain a trial shipment of ore in the hopes of developing a new market. Operated by the Eastern Mining and Metals Company Ltd., the mine, formerly Japanese-owned and situated at Dungun, Peranggu state north of Malaya, has sold 200,000 tons of ore to Japan this year.

Malayan iron ore is of a higher grade than that now mined in England. Malaya is the only country in the Far East now producing iron ore.

**Claims British Getting Dumber**

London—(AP)—Britons are getting dumber each generation, says Professor Godfrey Thomson, professor of education at Edinburgh university. He told the royal commission on population that intelligence is largely inherited and "intelligent people tend to produce smaller families so the average intelligence will sink generation by generation."

Professor J. B. S. Haldane, professor of biology at University College, London, pooh poohs this theory. "Grossly unintelligent" people, Haldane says in another paper to the commission, "are even less fertile than the highly intelligent. Existing data give no reason to suppose that the level of innate intellectual capacity in our population is falling."

**Rustlers Terrify Burmese Folk**

Rangoon—(AP)—Cattle-rustlers have halted rice cultivation at Kodauing, a large village south of Rangoon, according to the Rev. U. Ottama, a Buddhist monk.

U Ottama, here to seek governmental protection for the farmers, said the village-folk are considering mass emigration of their homes.

The monk said the rustlers are also kidnaping for ransom the more wealthy among the farmers. He stated the village was "terrified beyond words."

**Warsaw Pushes Reconstruction**

Warsaw—(AP)—The new Warsaw is rising hour by hour. Eighty thousand of its present 624,000 inhabitants are engaged in the vast reconstruction effort which is to be maintained until 1955.

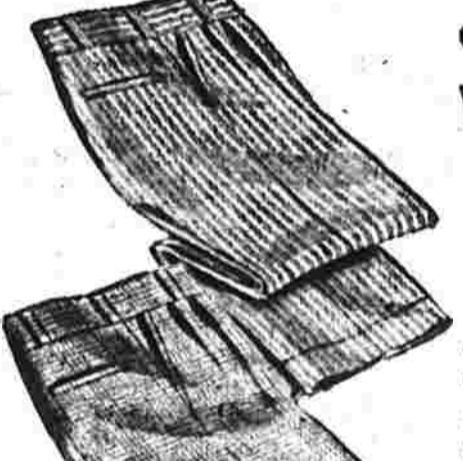

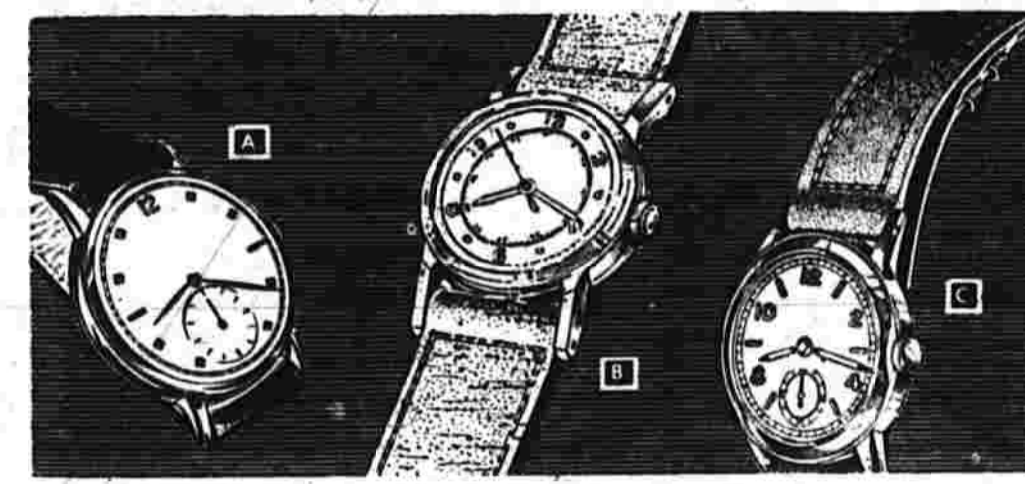

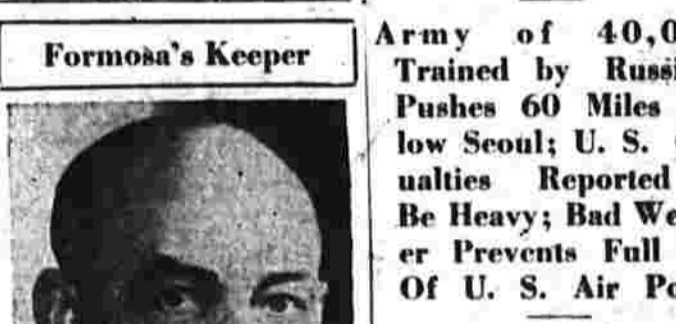
