A "Marshall Plan for Asia" was roposed last night for Korea and other Asiatics by Owen Lattimore, expert on Far Eastern affairs, as a means of strengthening their op-position to Communism. Lattimore, the No. 1 target of Senator McCarthy (R-Wis) before Senate Committee investigating Communists in the State Depar ment, made the proposal last night at the Mount Holyoke Institute on he United Nations. "The key to success is to bring
