With another era of higher prices in the offing, many people must often think of the "good old days" when you could go out and buy your shopping with just a few dollars.

Looking through a copy of the Herald dated September 24, 1937, about the time when Mussolini and Hitler were chummy and having much-publicized conferences, we found the following food prices advertised by local markets.

For 19 cents a pound you could buy fancy ducks, smoked shoulders and yearling lamb legs, turkeys were 25 cents a pound, pork was 18 cents a pound and rib pork was 15 cents a pound.

There were five pounds for a quarter, oranges 25 cents a dozen and potatoes 19 cents a sack. And for 15 cents you could buy two grapefruit. A dozen eggs, while butter came to 39 cents a pound.

OK, here are a few we just can't leave out: Whiskey, \$1.29 a quart, 100 proof alcohol for 44 cents, three cans of beer, 25 cents, four-year-old wine, 40 cents a fifth, six-year-old Scotch, \$1.98 a fifth, gin, \$1.25 a quart.

We could go into clothing too, but you get the idea.
