Korean Invasion Warning Sounded Last Fall, Is Claim

Knowland Says Rhee Told Him in November Reds Avowed Ending of China War To Invade South: U. S. Chiefs Were Told

Washington, Aug. 4.—(AP)—Senator Knowland (R., Calif.), disclosed today that he brought a special personal appeal from the president of South Korea to Washington officials for additional arms and defense equipment seven months before the North Korean Communists invaded in June. Knowland made the disclosure to reporters after Brigadier General William L. Roberts, former head of the U. S. military mission in Korea, had given senators secret testimony on the Korean situation. Senators said Roberts testified that Washington officials refused numerous requests for additional tanks, planes and heavy guns to arm South Koreans.

Christians Evacuated 2. North Koreans evacuated all civilians from a strip 10 miles wide above the 38th Parallel before the invasion started. 3. Roberts had no assigned military intelligence.

62,000 Enlisted Men to Be Activated to Complete Guard Divisions
