**Harmless Chemical Protects Grain**

Baltimore—(AP)—An insecticide which its makers say is the first to protect grain from insects and fungi in a foreign language, and which has more and more of a tendency, each year, to vote for the Democratic party, is being developed here. U. S. Industrial Chemicals, Inc., which has been developing the insecticide for four years, said that farmers are now using it to protect their crops because of insect damage.

The new insecticide is intended to prevent insects from invading stored grain. It's not recommended for treatment of grain already heavily infested. The company said the insecticide is not dangerous to humans or animals even when used in quantities far exceeding those recommended. The treated grain can be used for food and feed directly to livestock without special processing.

The product is a combination of a new chemical, piperyl butoxide, and pyrethrin. The insecticide is mixed with pulverized wheat or talc and is applied to the grain.
