Say Father of Three Confesses Killing 10-Year-Old Chicago Girl

Chicago, Aug. 14.—The girl slaying 10 months ago of 10-year-old Roberta Richardson has been marked "solved."

State's Attorney John S. Boyle said last night that 36-year-old father of three had retracted the kidnapping and slaying of a 10-year-old child near suburban La Grange the night of Dec. 17, 1948.

Boyle said a man, George Lettrich, Jr., admitted the crime during a lie detector examination early Sunday morning in which he also was questioned about two other sex offenses against young girls.

### Lodge Pledges To Extend Act

Temporary Housing Bill Due to Expire in May If No Action Taken

New Haven, Aug. 14.—(AP)—Executive action by the House of Representatives to extend the expiration date of the temporary housing act for at least one year beyond its expiration date of May 22, 1951, was pledged today by Congressman John Lodge, Republican candidate for governor. Speaking before the Women's Republican club of West Haven, Lodge drew attention to the fact that the more than 200 homes built under that act during the past year are still occupied, and will be vitally important, are scheduled, by law, to be demolished or removed next year.

"A governor," he said, "one of my first acts would be to request the General Assembly in its regular session of 1951 to extend the life of that law for at least another two months beyond May 22, 1951. This is a serious responsibility that must not be overlooked."

Stating that "Republican action has been indispensable in the entire state housing program," Lodge added that the Republican party has been the direct sponsor of fully four-fifths of all the public housing already provided for by the state.

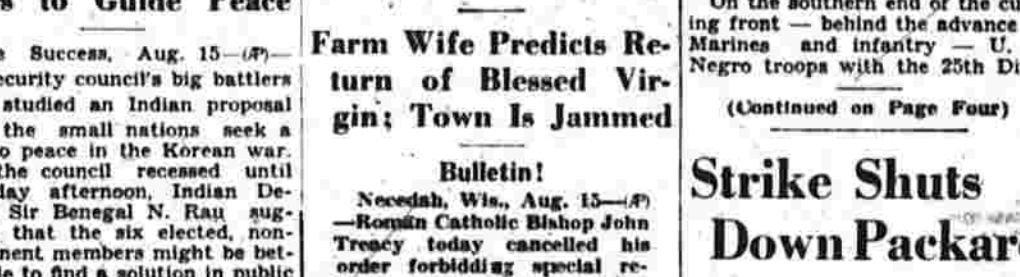

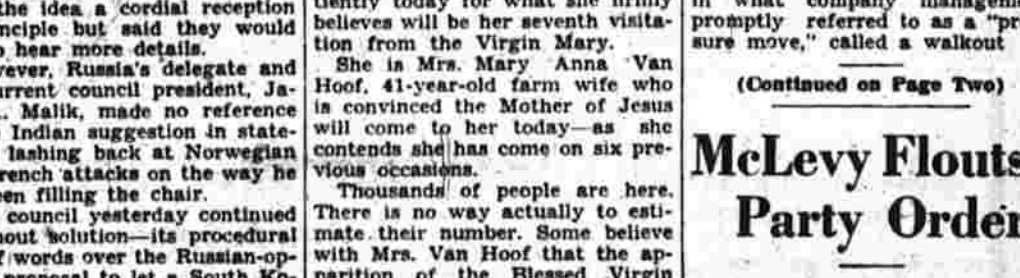

There was heavy fighting on other fronts. On the northeast rim of the 40-mile-long battlefront, Allied forces moved to within half mile of Red-held Pohang, forcing the U. S. 24th Division to supply base.



On the southern end of the current front—behind the advance Marines and infantry—U. S. Negro troops with the 25th Division.
