London, Aug. 15—(AP)—A princess was born today to Princess Elizabeth, heir-presumptive to the throne of the British Empire and her handsome husband, Prince Philip. The princess, second child of the royal couple, is third in line of succession to the British crown. She follows her chubby 21-month-old brother, Prince Charles.

The birth of the baby at Clarence House near Buckingham Palace, home of Elizabeth and Philip, pushed Elizabeth's sister, vicious Princess Margaret, into fourth place in the royal succession. A bulletin issued by the attending physicians said the baby came at 10:30 GMT (10:50 a. m. EDT) and that "her royal highness and her daughter are both doing well."
