Vet Director Explains Re-Employment Rights

Director G. J. Agostinelli, of the Veterans' Service Center and a volunteer Re-Employment Rights Committeeman of the U. S. Department of Labor, has received from Secretary of the position of the Armed Forces under the Selective Service Extension Act of 1950 Public Law 509. His Agostinelli pointed out that persons entering the Armed Forces are eligible for re-employment rights only if they fulfill all the conditions required by law.

He urged all employers, labor leaders, persons entering the Armed Forces, veteran leaders, and other interested persons to become familiar with these conditions. Voluntary entrance in military service does not deprive the person of the right to reclaim his job.

Here's What to Expect From the Atom Bomb

Commission Issues Book Of Latest Official Thinking on A-Bomb; Explodes Bugaboos

Washington (NEA) — Blinding light from a ball of fire hot as the sun, and a hundred times brighter to look at probably would be the first warning that a surprise-attack atom bomb had hit your town.

If it were the size dropped over Japan and exploded at about the same height from the ground, you very possibly would never know what hit you if you were within a half mile of it. But even in the half-mile radius there would be some survivors.

Properly destruction in the half-mile radius would be virtually complete.

The maximum distance for property damage would be about five miles and even at three miles an individual would be relatively safe. In a slit trench in your back yard you would be virtually out of danger as close as 4,500 feet, or just under a mile.

Burns from the explosion flash and those from the ordinary fires following an explosion would account for more than 50 per cent of deaths, if the pattern at Hiroshima and Nagasaki held true. Radiation would cause a maximum

of only 15 per cent of the deaths. The remainder would result principally from direct and indirect forces of the explosion's blast effect.

You can rest easier now. From here on there's better news. It's told by the Atomic Energy Commission in an official new book titled "The Effects of Atomic Weapons" and it does a good job of laying the ghost of one-dreaded radiation.

A military spokesman commenting on the radiation aspects of the bomb tossed a small one himself by stating it would be "probably very safe" to go into the heart of the bomb area within 10 seconds after the blast, 90 seconds at most. He was speaking of a bomb exploded above the earth, as in Japan.

An atomic energy spokesman went even further in saying that from an air burst there would be no radiological contamination.

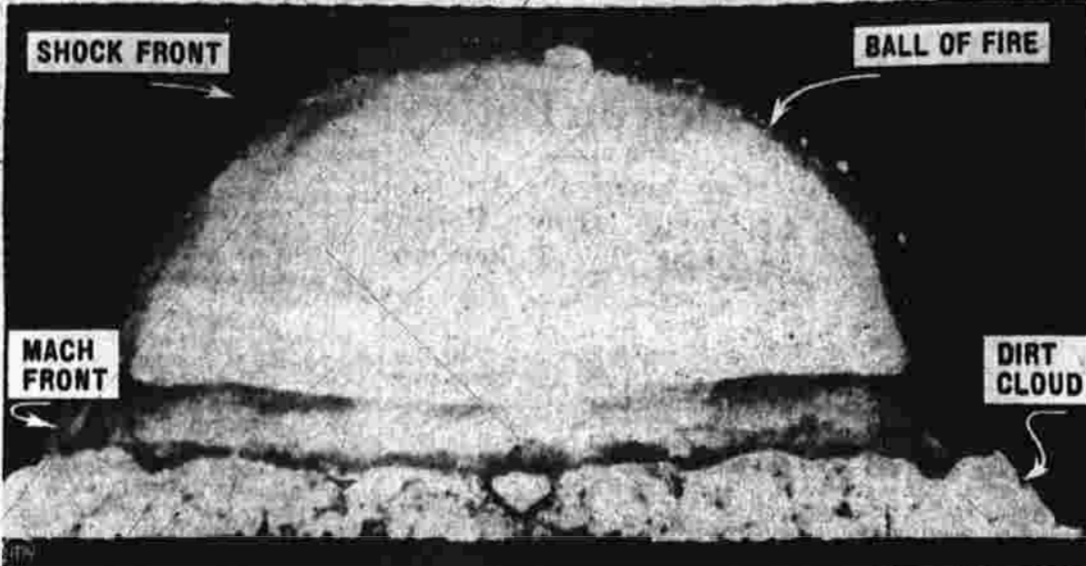
The book says on this point: "After an air burst at low altitude an area—small compared with the damage area due to the bomb—will be uninhabitable because of the radiation hazard. It goes on to say that a vehicle traveling fairly fast could cross the contaminated area about 15 minutes after the explosion.

It would be safe to walk across the area after six hours. Rescue and first-aid workers, properly clothed and shielded, probably could work there with only infrequent interruption. It would probably be some time, however, before unprotected persons could re-

The Atomic Energy Commission believes there is, and explains why in a book just issued, "The Effects of Atomic Weapons," which represents the latest official thinking on an awesome subject. 4,500 feet from the explosion a race of monsters, such a thing "is extremely improbable," say the experts.

It was once thought that nuclear radiations were responsible for leaving many burn victims in Japan with disgusting overgrowths of scar tissue called keloids. The book says no. It is now known that the disfigurements were caused by secondary infections in the burns and by malnutrition. In addition, the tendency toward keloid formations is a racial characteristic of the Japanese.

The burn infections resulted largely from a lack of medical facilities and supplies. As a result, the agonized victims used whatever they could lay their hands on, from mud to molasses and said no charges were filed against him.
