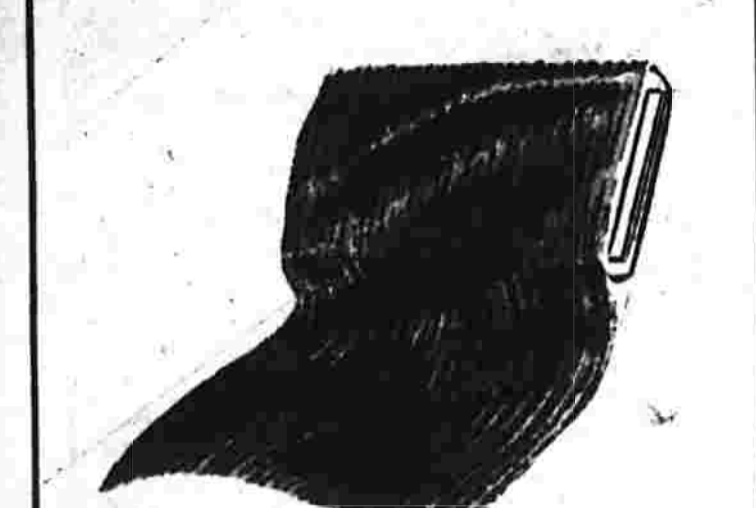

Giant Fish Dies, Failing Rescuer

Some commercial fishermen at Seaside Park, N. J., 67 miles from Philadelphia, and helped them haul in the eight-pound, five-foot sun fish in their nets.

Volks immediately volunteered to drive the fish to the Philadelphia Aquarium to give him to his friend, Harry R. Lindeman, the Aquarium superintendent.

He placed the fish in a tank trailer attached to his car and hurried to Philadelphia. The fish appeared to be much worse in the tank than from time to time Volks stopped to add more water to the tank.

On its arrival, the giant fish looked some too heavy. Lindeman had him placed in an empty tank nine by 18 feet, and the fish quickly jumped to the bottom.

At Lindeman's suggestion, Volks jumped into the tank to "wake" the fish. To walk a fish, one places it straight and gently moves it back and forth.

Two hours and 20 minutes Volks worked patiently. The six-foot sun fish stood on its feet, up to his shoulders, pushing his hands forward and backward.

With Lindeman giving instructions, Volks applied pressure behind the fish's gills, which like a man's lungs enables a fish to breathe.

Then, exhausted and disheartened, Volks climbed out of the tank. The fish was dead.

Lindeman and the fish apparently had not been injured but had suffered from lack of deep sea water on his trip here.

"It was an aquatic animal, and he was out of his element," Lindeman said. He explained that the fish, known as a Sea Cow hereabouts normally lives in its home on the ocean floor and probably was swept toward shore by the recent Atlantic hurricane.

Zoologically speaking, a Sea Cow is a Manatee, a different aquatic specimen.

State police on a charge of assault with intent to murder. At a preliminary hearing before Trial Judge Alvin Haines at nearby Ridgefield, he was ordered held without bail. His case was continued until next Tuesday.

Circus Offers To Pay Claims

Immediate Payment of Fire Damages Rests On Dropping Interest

Hartford, Aug. 24.—The Niagara Brothers and Burnum and Bailey Combined Shows has offered "immediate" payment of \$60,012 in settlement of all unpaid claims arising out of the tragic circus fire which took 158 lives and injured hundreds here in 1944.

The circus over the past several years has been paying off the \$3,464,255 claims made against it as a result of the fatal blaze in periodic installments, plus a per cent interest on the unpaid balance. Acceptance of the offer made by the circus, it was stressed, would mean loss of more than \$27,000 annual interest to claimants, but also would free the circus from the burden of paying another three years for final settlement as now is the case.
