All Municipal Employees to Come Under the New Schedule

The Board of Directors has acted to establish a 40-hour work week for all municipal employees as a matter of policy as of January 1. It has been reported by General Manager George H. Waddell that except in two cases, the water department and the cemetery department, labor adjustments can be made so that the work can be done without hitting additional help. The water and cemetery forces might have to be slightly increased if the 40-hour schedule goes into effect for the new policy. In approving the new policy, it was with provision that those now working more than 40 hours will suffer no reduction in pay and those regular employees working less than 40 hours will work longer hours to commensurate increase. Hourly workers and part time workers would not be affected.
