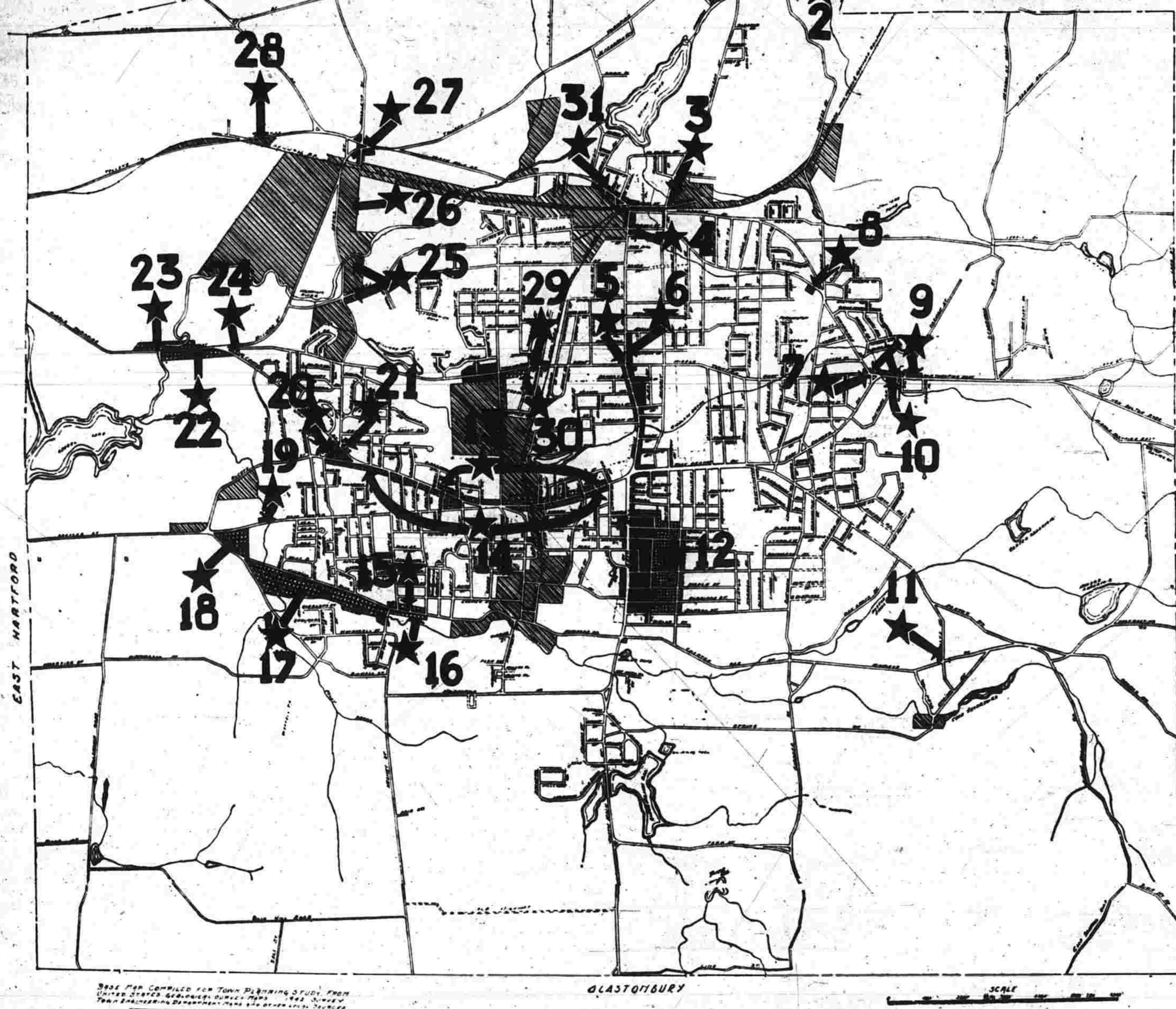

'X-Ray Martyr' Meets Death

Dr. Percy Brown, 74, in Poor Health from 'Radioactive Damage'

Egypt, Mass., Oct. 8.—Dr. Percy Brown, an X-ray pioneer, died at 74 after a scientific career which he once said exposed him to an "experimental kind of death."
The first radiologist to be appointed to the Harvard Medical School, Dr. Brown took up the study of roentgen rays in 1903. Thirty-one years later he retired, he said, of "ill health due to the effects of prolonged radiation."
Associates said he underwent more than 50 operations on his skin areas during his career as a martyr to X-ray. Dr. John F. Conlin, medical information officer of the Massachusetts Medical Society, said in a report for the 80th anniversary class book of his Harvard college class, Dr. Brown wrote in 1934:
"Many a scientist has suffered death as a result of radioactive damage. Thus far I have been fortunate enough to escape through my physical handicaps because of my injuries, such as excruciating pain in one massive explosive cancer which has been many a time removed.
