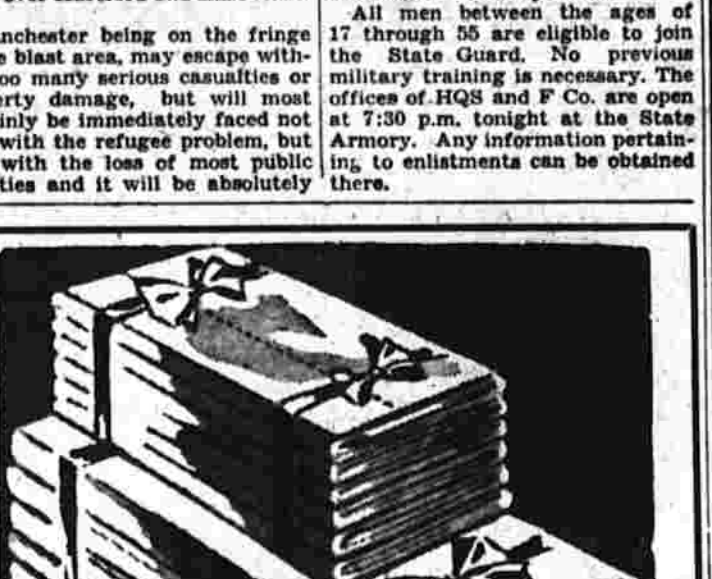

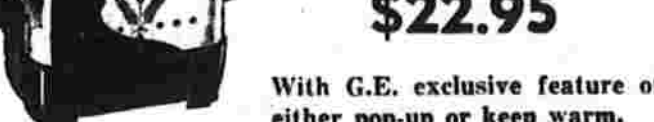

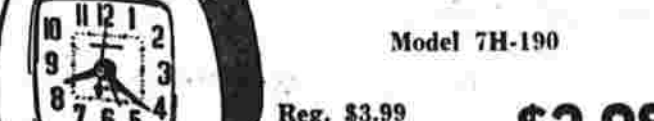

Answers Query On X-Ray Project

Matthew M. Moriarty, chairman of the Manchester... X-ray program, in response to questions asked why those under 15 years of age are not included in the survey has made the following statement:

"From experience of mass X-ray surveys conducted it has been found that a very small percentage of children under 15 years of age show any significant diseases of the chest on the X-ray film unless they are acutely sick, for example with pneumonia or acute respiratory infection. Under those circumstances it is dangerous for them to go to an X-ray survey; they should be taken at once to a physician who can make a complete examination and offer immediate advice and medical treatment."

Chairman Moriarty further added, "so very few children under 15 years of age have acute tuberculosis that it is inexpedient to examine them. In fact, all the groups in the population the children under 15 have the best tuberculosis. Besides this, many school systems have a health program which provides chest and chest X-ray examination for high school students and it would be undesirable to duplicate it."

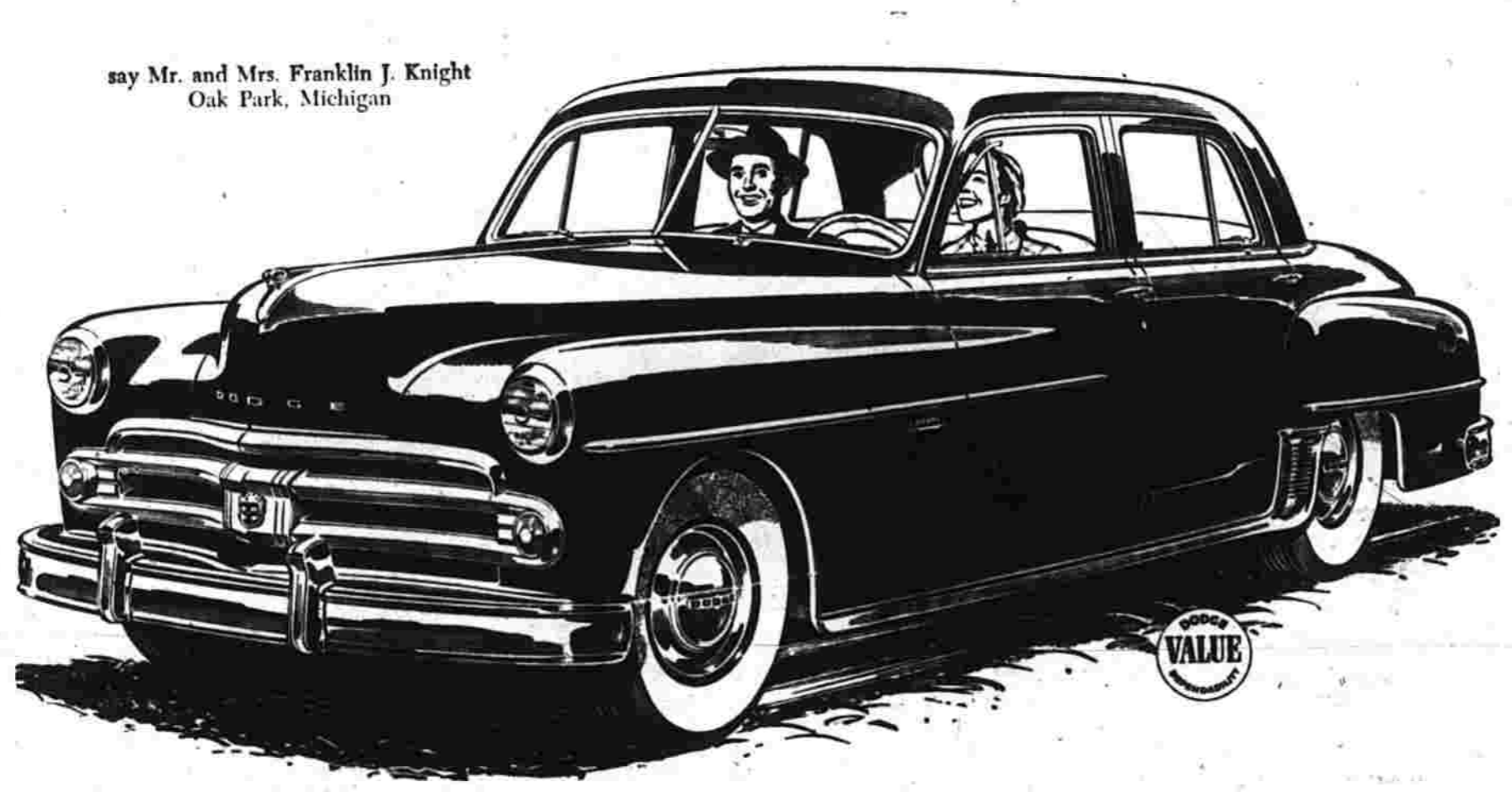
