Deny Judges' Right to Rule On Poll Issue

Democrats Claim Only The Senate Can Authorize Re-Tally of Votes In Benton-Bush

Hartford, Nov. 14.—(AP)—Democrats and Republicans got into a legal wrangle today as to whether a panel of three State Supreme Court Justices has the right to order a recount of the close election returns for the Connecticut short term Senate seat.
