Hartford Flier Dies in Crash Of Guard Plane

Lieutenant Bristol, Father of Four, Killed in Coast Accident; Had Worked at P. and W.

Hartford, Dec. 8 (AP)—First Lieutenant Arthur N. Bristol, of Hartford, father of four children—the eldest four—was killed Wednesday night when his Connecticut Air National Guard plane crashed near Tacoma, Wash.

Staff Sergeant Troy, a member of the New York Air Guard, was also killed in the crash.

Lieut. Bristol and Sgt. Troy were enroute from Larson Air Force Base at Moses Lake, Wash., to McChord Field to pick up military equipment. The aircraft have been on active duty for the past six weeks at Larson AFB, where the plane, a B-26 Superfortress, was engaged in towing targets for anti-aircraft artillery practice.

Lieut. Bristol, a World War II veteran, leaves his widow, Nancy Hanson Bristol, and three children today: Lois, 4; Donna, 2 1/2; and Margaret Ann, 3 months.

Official said, is that the order involves the allocation of shipping space.

The impact will be felt by American carriers—planes and ships—operating between foreign ports. Virtually identical bans already exist on movements direct from the U. S. to China, Hong Kong, Macao and Soviet Europe.

Violations of the order would be subject to penalties as high as \$10,000 fine and a year in prison. In addition, violating carriers could be denied operating privileges, which would mean going out of business.

To protect affected carriers against suits for breach of contract, Fleming's order declared: "No person shall be held liable for damages or penalties for any default under any contract or order which shall result directly or indirectly from compliance with the understanding that this order or section of the Defense Production Act shall thereafter be declared by judicial or other competent authority to be invalid."

December Critical Month For Walkers, Chief Asserts

Do you cross the street backward? Do you wear blinders? Do you doze off in mid-street? The chances are that you don't. Yet Chief of Police Herman O. Schendel pointed out that the average pedestrian will pull a dozen stunts every day that are no less dangerous and foolish than the most reckless driving.

"Nearly 9,000 pedestrians were killed last year," Chief Schendel said. "Of these more than 1,000 died in December. When the streets were choked with Christmas shoppers and the weather added the driver's job of dodging them twice as hard."

Hasty pedestrians all too often have their minds on holiday festivities instead of the dangers at hand. This, plus snow and icy conditions and the night's darkness characteristic of December were cited by Chief Schendel in explaining the surprising number of pedestrian deaths last year among walkers.

"Pedestrians stopping in heavy traffic with their arms full of packages, or with their umbrellas pulled down over their heads like stocking caps, are a common sight this month," Chief Schendel said. "Add this carelessness to the slick streets that make stopping a car difficult, and to the heavy darkness that settles over us about four o'clock every afternoon, and December's pedestrian toll—greater than any other month—begins to make sense."

Chief Schendel cited the absolute necessity for redoubled caution.

Phone Service Rates Increase

Revision of Charges Is Asked; Would Mean 40 Cents a Month Rise

A revision of the existing schedule of rates for individual line telephone service was filed with the Public Utilities Commission today by The Southern New England Telephone Company. The proposed changes, subject to approval by the Commission, would increase total company revenues by 4 per cent, or about \$150,000 a month.

Individual line residence rates would be increased by 33 to 45 cents a month, depending on the size of exchange. Increases for flat rate individual line business service would range from \$1.00 to \$1.50 a month. Rates in the Manchester exchange would be increased 40 cents a month for individual line residence service and \$1.25 for flat rate, individual business lines.

No change is proposed in the rates for party-line service, message rate business or any other type of telephone service or equipment. Rates for toll calls between exchanges are not affected, but on calls from 10 cents through 25 cents the initial talking period would be reduced by one minute.

"Like many other businesses, we are now forced to ask for a price adjustment in order to meet the rising costs of materials, wages and taxes," Alorton F. Brooks, president of the company, said today. "In the last two years wage increases alone have amounted to nearly four million dollars annually. Welfare Costs Are Increased

More Than \$260 Over The Month Before: Reason for the Boost

THIS IS IT

The November town welfare costs were \$260.10 more than in October, according to the report for the past month filed by Welfare Director Albert E. Brennan today. The increase in costs arose even though the number of persons aided declined, the fact being caused by the making of a cost of living adjustment in department salaries.

In November there were 109 persons aided in 74 cases for an expenditure of \$7,687.23.

In October the number aided was 137 persons in 77 cases for \$7,427.13. During November a year ago there were 124 persons helped in 83 cases, and \$41,095 was spent, showing a sizeable reduction in the present year from the relief burden of a year ago.

Big Transport On Korea Duty Is Sabotaged. Vessel Damaged in 5 Different Places at Seattle Dock; Press Quest for Saboteurs.

Seattle, Dec. 8.—A big naval transport just back from carrying troops and supplies to Korea, was sabotaged at a Seattle dock this week.

Military and civilian investigators pressed an intensive search today for the saboteurs. The incident was made public last night by Navy Capt. M. O. Eaton, Deputy Commander of the Military Sea Transportation Service (MSTS) in the North Pacific.

He said the vessel was damaged extensively in five different places by someone "not on our ball game."

He did not specify what parts of the ship had been sabotaged nor estimate how long it would take to make repairs.

Under tight guard the transport was under light security guard. The civilian crew had been screened insofar as it was possible.

Both Eaton and other Navy officers said it was virtually impossible for an unauthorized person to get aboard.

Military sources said that as far as they knew it was the first such act of sabotage since the outbreak of war in Korea.

Eaton first said the damaged transport was the Navy's Gen. A. W. Greely, AC-1 type of 12,000 tons. The Greely docked here early this week from the Orient.
