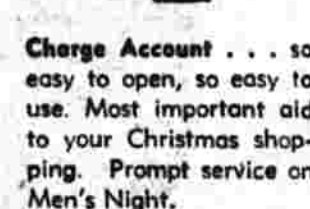

### Attlee's Influence

Prime Minister Attlee has come and gone. Without undue respect to the intercommunalism issued by Mr. Attlee and Mr. Truman, it can be said that the most important thing about Mr. Attlee's visit was that it lasted almost a week.

During this period, at least, United States policy was held in a state of suspension. The effort to reach decisions with Mr. Attlee, although futile in some respects for itself, nevertheless performed the function of stalling off any unilateral decision on the part of the United States.

Mr. Attlee brought several things to Washington that were needed in the frantic atmosphere which was inspired by the sudden collapse of United Nations forces in Korea.

One of these was the reminder that the United States is not alone in the world, neither in its resistance to Communism, nor in its possible wisdom for formulating and executing that resistance.

Another related reminder was to the effect that there is still such a thing as the United Nations—something Washington statesmen were tending to forget as they viewed the defeat in Korea purely as a defeat for America.

Another thing Mr. Attlee brought with him was a sense of history, by which we mean something to relate the events of a day and a week to the issues of a year or a decade.

So Mr. Attlee represented a tempering and sobering influence on American instincts, he reminded us that, not being alone, it behooves us to formulate policy which will not alienate those who are with us, and, at a time when American impulse toward drastic decisions was hot, he, by maintaining his presence here for a week, called time for full thought and deliberation.

What the gain from all this may be depends upon other nations, with their force-making efforts, and particularly upon Communist China, which may also, during this interim, have had time to reflect, as we have, upon the fruitless total tragedy the world is approaching.

### Asset Or Liability?

One of the most insistent demands of the Chiang Kai-shek enthusiasts in this country since the start of the Korean war has been that Chiang be permitted to send some of his troops to the Korean theatre. It has been argued that it is treachery on the part of President Truman to permit American boys to carry so heavy a load in Korea, when Chiang's troops were ready and willing to help.

All of this has apparently been based on the assumption that Chiang's troops would be an asset in Korea.

This point of view overlooks the fact that there are already Chiang troops in Korea. It overlooks the fact that Korea is flooded with Chinese soldiers carrying American weapons.

While China has his present army committed on Formosa, it is necessarily loyal, at least up to the moment the Chinese Communists may appear on Formosa.

**Unbent About Men**

It was the General's first statement to correspondents on the Korean campaign since he was directed the Allied end-of-the-war offensive at daybreak Nov. 24, a push turned into a full retreat the night of Nov. 25 by huge-blasting hordes of Chinese infanteries.

It was evident that MacArthur was concerned seriously about the condition of his forces, particularly the U. S. First Marine division and units of the Army's Seventh Infantry Division which battled through a frozen, Chinese-lined hell for two weeks on both sides and south of the Changjin Reservoir in northeast Korea.

A Marine spokesman said the last elements of the 25,000-man corps had completed the hazardous, winding descent from snowbound mountains ringing the big hydroelectric reservoir to the coastal plain leading to Hamhung.

**Longest Marine Retreat**

The bitter 50-mile retreat—the longest and one of the fiercest in the history of the spirited Marine Corps—began Nov. 28. The spokesman estimated the Leathernecks alone killed 15,000 Chinese in breaking through the series of traps.

With the Marines were the 31st and 32nd Regiments of the Seventh Division and about 100 British Royal Marines. They joined forces Sunday with a northbound task force of the U. S. Third Division after a vital bridge, blown by the Chinese, was repaired.

One grimy, bewhiskered Leatherneck, huddled in his tattered parka, probably expressed the feelings of all of them with this comment:

"It was tough. That's all—tough."

**Clio Tarawa Figures**

A Marine medical officer compared the Leatherneck casualties to those the corps suffered in taking the tiny atoll of Tarawa in World War II—more than 4,000 total Marine and doughnut casualties were higher.
