Tobacco Men Urged to Vote

All Growers of State Asked to Register Opinion on Marketing

The Connecticut State Farm Bureau Tobacco committee urges all tobacco growers to vote on the tobacco marketing quota referendum on Wednesday, December 20. The hours at all polling places will be from 9 a. m. to 6 p. m. Farmers of East Hartford and Manchester are to vote in the Town Office building, East Hartford, and those of South Windsor are to vote in the South Windsor Town Hall. There are other polling places throughout the state. The referendum has been declared by the Secretary of Agriculture to determine whether or not to continue with marketing quotas. Farmers will vote on whether or not they wish to continue with quotas and still have price support or whether they want to abandon controls altogether. If two-thirds of the voting vote in favor of retaining the quotas they will be continued. If the status which raises binder type of tobacco are voting in the referendum on December 20. Thomas M. Burgess, Jr., of Wapping, chairman of the Connecticut State Farm Bureau committee, urges all farmers who raise tobacco to get out and vote next Wednesday. All persons engaged in the 1950 production of tobacco are eligible to vote.

Local Patrolman is Promoted; Member of Force Ten Years

George C. Dent, of 208 Middle Turnpike, east, has been promoted from patrolman to sergeant in the Manchester Police department. It was announced last night by Chief of Police Herman O. Schendel at a department inspection held at the Municipal Building.

Sergeant Dent was appointed a supernumerary on December 2, 1949, and a regular on November 16, 1949. He was formerly employed as a plant guard by the United Aircraft Corporation in East Hartford and held the rank of corporal. Sergeant Dent is married and has two children.

Cut Down Accidents Chief Schendel instructed his men last night to make a concentrated effort to cut down the speed of vehicles on all streets in Manchester. The number of accidents and occupant injuries has increased in the past several weeks, Schendel said, because vehicles were going too fast. A speed of over 30 miles an hour on any street within the town is excessive, he added, while 25 is to be considered the safe limit on the outskirts.

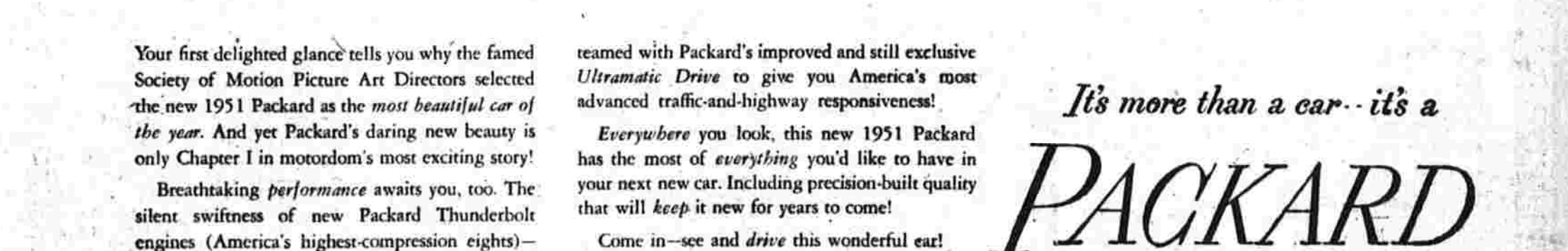

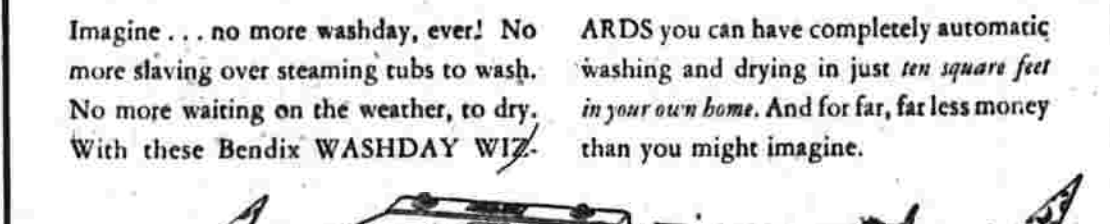

Cease-Fire Move Approved The 13-nation Arab-Asian bloc in the United Nations has developed a series of steps toward peace, the first of which is the adoption by the General Assembly of the resolution appointing a special committee to try to arrange a cease-fire in Korea.

As we noted yesterday, both Russia and the United States are objecting to phases of the Arab-Asian bloc program. Yesterday, at Lake Success, it was Russia's opposition which was on view, as the United States announced that it favored having all foreign troops leave Korea immediately.

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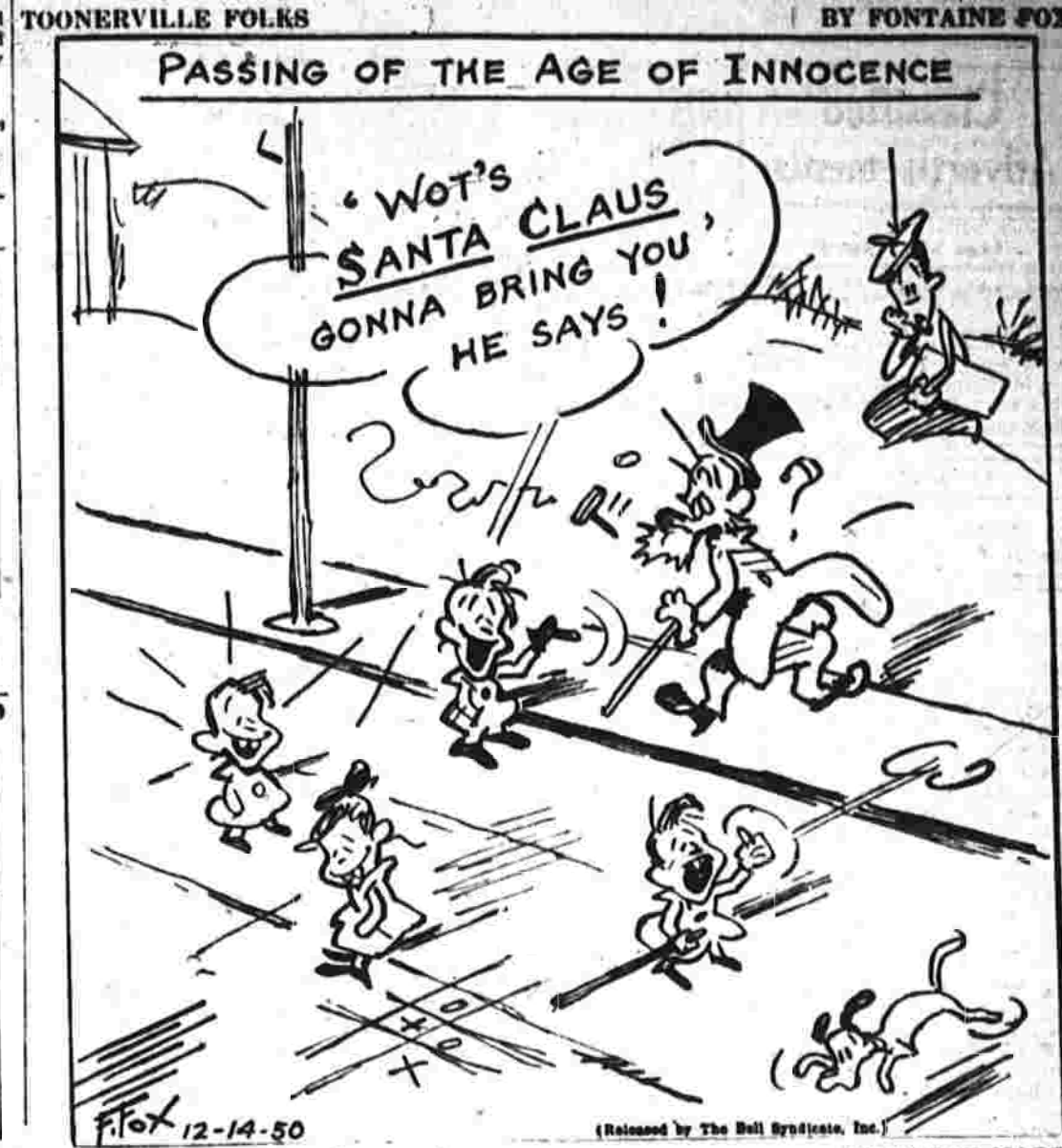
