Hoover's Recommendations

Former President Herbert Hoover must be credited with consistency. When the world's problem was Nazi aggression, he recommended that we let rage where it pleased abroad, while we concentrated on the defense of our own shores. If he reckoned with the possibility that we might find ourselves alone in the world against overwhelming world forces, his conclusion was still that we could make ourselves an impregnable hemisphere island.

Now the world's problem is that of Communist aggression, and Mr. Hoover's formula is the same. He would concentrate on the defense of this hemisphere, letting Communism have what it pleased in Europe and in Asia.

In 1939 and 1940, Mr. Hoover's present counsel seemed a message of complete despair to the other free peoples involved in the fate of the world. As then, it amounts to a perfunctory invitation to aggression, come forward and take what they please. And, as then, it represents the natural instinct of perhaps one-third of the American people, who still cling to the idea that this country can successfully stay out of "foreign wars," and who argue that this nation's first mission in the world is to protect itself from the postures of western civilization, no matter what else may have to be sacrificed toward that end.

Now, as then, Mr. Hoover hopes that such a military and diplomatic course will enable us to balance the budget.

The issue posed by Mr. Hoover is fundamental. Can we live alone in the world, safely and prosperously? Or must we live in the world, part of its tragedy and trouble, but also its main hope?

Mr. Hoover's answer is that the venture of living in the world, as represented by our participation in two World Wars, and by our participation in the United Nations, has failed, and that even the other free peoples of the world have proved themselves unworthy of our friendship.

We must take stock. Quarrel with all this: To surrender all Europe and Asia is, to our mind, the extreme in appeasement. To assume that the nation can be destroyed is to abandon that principle of world law which is the last best hope of earth, and that principle which must be maintained, live, despite setbacks, if there is to be life for any part of the world.

Finally, to assume that we have only two choices—defeat abroad or isolationism—is too closed and artificial a view of our world opportunities and responsibilities. Both peace and war are inevitable in our world. We are in that world beyond any instinctive decision to withdraw from it. We are in that world standing for certain principle, without which we cannot live ourselves. That principle has its military, political, diplomatic, moral bearings on the 38th parallel in Korea just as much as it has on the coast of California. We don't know whether we can help bring peace to the whole world, but we know that if we cannot do that, we cannot have peace ourselves either. Wherever freedom is in danger, there we are in danger too. We must struggle as best we can.

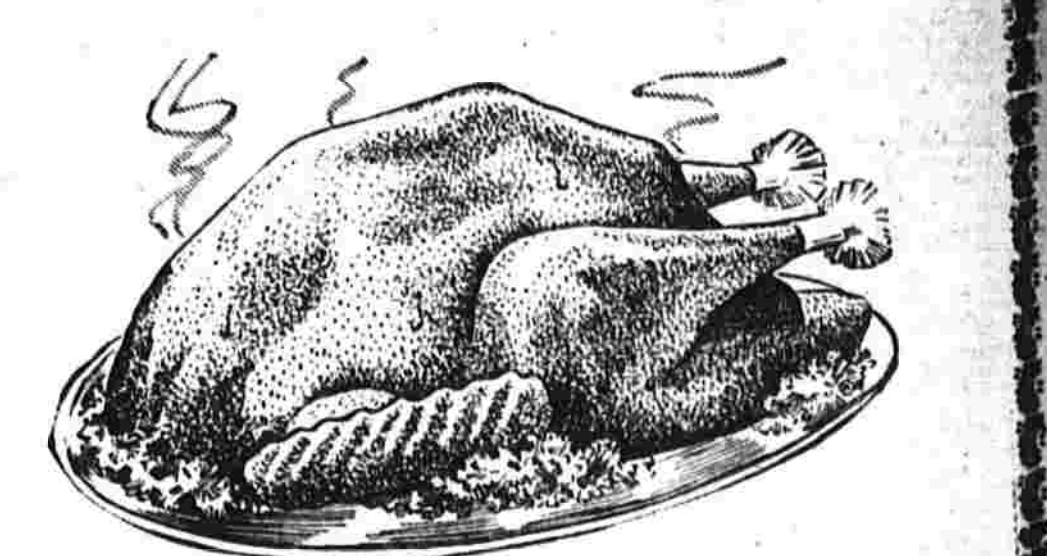

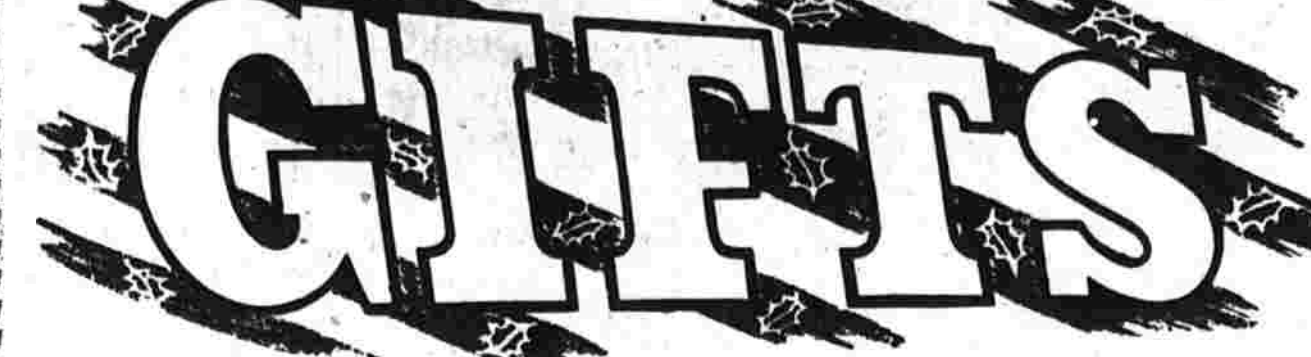

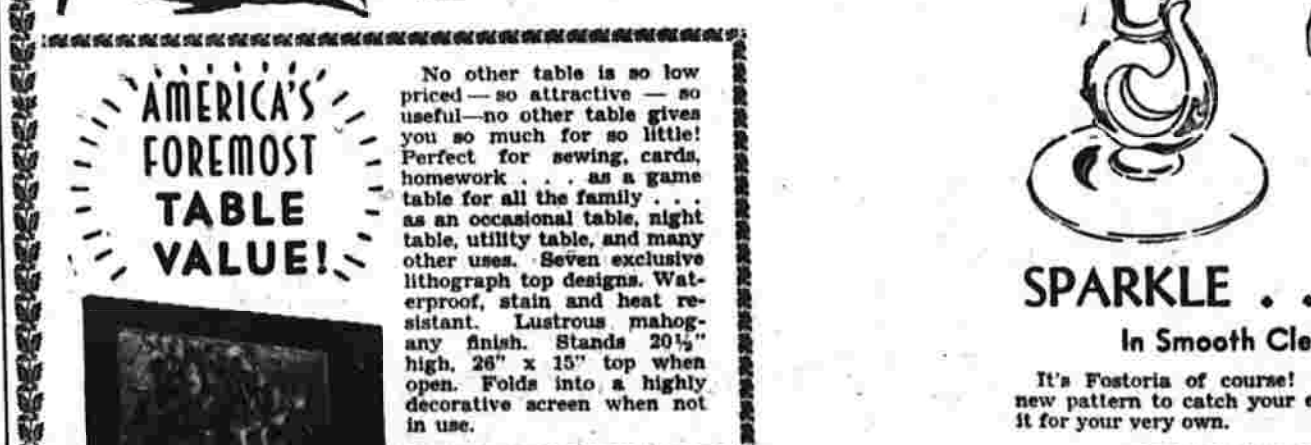
