 consider the needs of all

 evils of Communism, yet it may  
 well be that Communism would  
 die if it were not for the  
 evils upon which it feeds.  
 "The National Association of

 statement that what the union  
 is asking is not 'from 50 to 60  
 cents an hour' but 'from 50 to  
 60 cents an hour'.
