

Rockville No Vote Taken To End Strike

Rockville, Feb. 24 (Special)—Striking textile workers at the M. T. Stevens and Son company here apparently do not intend to go back to work yet.

More than 800 workers convened in a large auditorium last night but took no action to end the two weeks old stoppage at the Rockville mills.

Raymond V. Dick, president of Local 8, Textile Workers Union of America, and George Ballantyne, TWU vice president, reviewed negotiations with the company.

Dick reminded the workers that they had offered no motion for back-to-work action.

Dick also announced suspension of 48 members who have continued to work during the strike.
