Legend has it that an old Indian discovered the mine in 1890 coming out with a fortune of gold to New Westminster, B. C., near there. The Indian, named Chin-mah, made several trips to the mine, each time returning with a sack of gold.

He died on the fallows in 1892 at New Westminster after confessing the murder of eight women.

Each trip he took an Indian woman to the mine. Name returned and he kept the location of "Lost Creek" secret.

One American, who came back with a fearsome tale of hardship and disaster and a packload of \$10,000 in gold, died a short time later.

He said the creek lost itself in a mountain tunnel, but he gave no other details.

Twenty other men have hunted for the lost mine. None returned.

Broad Street School Cost Jamming Action

Bid Levels Indicate Expenses Reaching Over \$900,000 Appropriation Study Problem

The future of Manchester's projected new broad street elementary school is undecided today as town officials start study of yesterday's awards bid for the construction. With a total appropriation of \$900,000 set aside for the school, the lowest figure on construction alone—apart from grading, furnishing, landscaping and other large incidentals—stands at \$877,826. With the \$20,000 rough grading contract already awarded the C. J. Hale Construction company of this town, the apparent cost of the grounds improvement and bare school building will be \$897,726, leaving only an impossibly small margin for furnishing and completion.

Need is Acute The need of the broad street school building is so acute that it is not likely the building plans will be dropped. There is little likelihood that the size of the school can be cut—already there are indications it will be full on opening day. Further delay might result in any possible small benefit progressively higher costs. The demand, plus the feeling that no reduction can be squeezed out of planning, leaves a need to seek more funds. This might be done one of several ways. The taxpayers might appropriate more money than the \$900,000 set aside now.
