### Garden Club Enjoys Talk

The Manchester Garden Club held its April meeting Monday evening in the Robbins room of the club house. Mrs. Robert S. Denison, Mrs. Paul Higgins and Mrs. John Mason.

Mrs. H. H. Learned directed attention to the annual House and Garden Tour in Hartford, May 15 and 16, for the benefit of the Hartford Art school. Mrs. Learned has tickets to sell to those interested.

Program Chairman Ellen Buckley announced that a flower arranging clinic would be held at the next meeting in May and members were asked to bring either a high low container, a flower holder, scissors or a knife and fairly long stemmed flowers.

Mrs. Henry Rockwell, the president, turned the business meeting over to Mrs. E. J. Kelly who presented Roderick Crockett of the West Hartford Garden Center. Mr. Crockett gave the members a great deal of information on annuals, calling them the ABC's of gardening. He stated that people are sometimes skeptical as to their ability to grow flowers from the pictures in the catalogue. However, he said they are often better as the pictures and can be as well as fragrance. Many times as many as a dozen varieties may come from one seed packet.

He also stated that a garden of all one color is easier to achieve with annuals. Actually there are thousands of species found growing in all parts of the world however he gave the members the twenty-five best and commonest of annuals. Strangely enough the common name of the Zinnia which is "Youth and Old" has been forgotten and most people refer to it by its botanical name.

In conclusion, Mr. Crockett told the members how to start their annuals early from seeds in flat or cold frames, or later in the season in the garden, pointing out that plants get ten per cent of their life from the soil and the rest from the air and sun. Therefore they need a balanced ration of everything from the start.

With the exception of Stan Musial, who may lose his \$25,000 raise, no other major league players in general will be affected by the new government ruling which puts a control on the salaries.

The Wage Stabilization Board in Washington has decided today to put a ceiling on baseball salaries. This is what it amounts to: A baseball team can't pay any player more than it paid its highest paid player in 1950.

Last season, Musial, the Cardinals' highest paid player, received a reported \$50,000. This season he reportedly got a \$35,000 increase. But under the new ruling, he automatically will be paid his 1950 salary.

Musial would lose his pay hike, but the team would receive \$15,000 more in total payroll.

Other players who have received pay raises are: Fred Stutz of Detroit, who has received a \$10,000 raise; Tomlin of the Yankees, who has received a \$5,000 raise; and Eddie Stanky, who has received a \$15,000 raise.

Stanky has received a \$15,000 raise because Detroit pitcher Newhouse received \$50,000 last season as Detroit's highest-paid player.

Outfielder Al Zarilla and first baseman Eddie Robinson of the Chicago White Sox are not so fortunate. Both have received raises. Zarilla's raise was \$10,000 and Robinson's was \$5,000.

Joe DiMaggio of the Yankees and Ralph Kinzler of Pittsburgh are also affected since they are getting the same salary as last year.

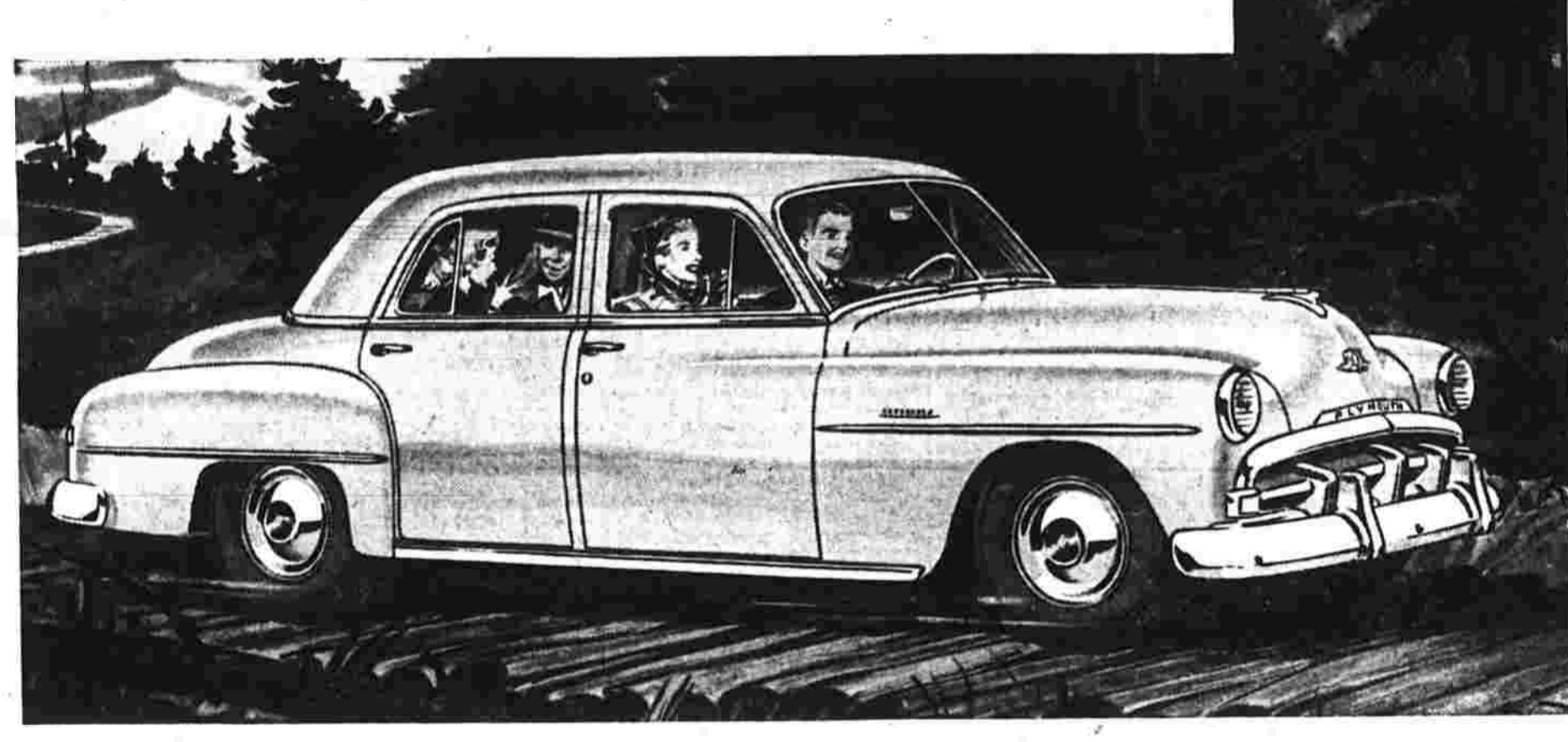
