The Anti-British Theme
 There is one rather consistent theme which seems to crop out in the editorial and political comment which takes the side of General MacArthur. It is the allegation that, in firing MacArthur, President Truman bowed to British policy. And British policy, according to the same allegation, is one of preserving British trade with Communist China at all costs. That, according to the argument, is the reason Britain did not attack China, and therefore the reason why President Truman fired General MacArthur. So, in this version, the whole historic incident is merely a case of Britain dominating the decisions in a United States war in order to preserve its own opportunities for economic gain. One of the trophies usually thrown into this argument is the statement that Secretary of State Dean Acheson looks and speaks and thinks like an Englishman.

We don't know quite what to do with this argument. It is the same type of argument which was used, once before, when Britain was standing all alone against Hitler, and some Americans were arguing that Britain deserved credit for the whole historic incident. This whole nation went through that argument and to its credit, had answered it with Lend-Lease, even before Pearl Harbor came to us.

Now this same distaste for things British is in the national limelight again with the difference that what was once a plot to ensnare us in a war which was "none of our business" has now become a plot to dominate the strategy in a war which it would seem to be charged, is none of Britain's business.

Perhaps the first thing that ought to be said is that Britain does not in any sense deserve credit for the MacArthur dismissal, and that, if the conduct of our fellow allies in the United Nations is to be characterized at all, it should be considered a conduct of unusual restraint in the circumstances. Washington's vacillations and MacArthur's insubordinations have created.

ing the war to China proper because Britain believes that this is a belief which is quite soundly founded in the terms of the defensive alliance existing between Russia and Communist China.

Finally, it is not only the British who hold that the United Nations objective in Korea should be to compel aggression, but not to be in punitive conquest. That view is most often expressed, in international circles, by the French, who have no significant trade interest in China.
