### CD Head Aims Plan to Care For Evacuees

**Outlines Program for 100 Welfare Centers Throughout State for Bomb Disaster Duty**

Hartford, April 19.—The organization of 100 welfare centers to care for evacuees in a bombing disaster was outlined today by Dana S. Merriman, State Civil Defense Chief of Education and Welfare Services.

The plan is to be carried out through the use of volunteer workers and established organizations. The program will be completed by recruitment of volunteer workers, Merriman stated.

Merriman's plan for the transportation and care of evacuees involves three zones at varying distances from a target center or the area directly damaged by the bombing.

Near to the damaged area is the "collection point" ring where, from various points, easily accessible to prescribed Civil Defense evacuation centers will be collected and transferred to the next zone where the "target area" welfare stations are located.

Functions of registration, mass feeding, temporary lodging, emergency clothing, emergency financial assistance, etc.

Evacuees will be processed—sent to relative, friends or established welfare agencies. Those with no definite destination will be transported to the third zone where the "straggler area" welfare stations have been set up.

The 100 centers will effect a more permanent disposition of evacuees, including relocation of the homeless and destitute, reemployment of essential defense workers and new jobs for as many others as possible. Institutional care for the aged, homeless, orphans, infirm and casualties will be provided.

Collection points will be fair grounds, athletic fields, armories, warehouse town halls, etc., with feeding facilities. They will serve as clearing houses, from where evacuees will be routed to welfare centers.

Each point will have a staff which will include a manager, transportation chief and assistant.

### French Ex-Marshall In Grave Condition, Will Be 95 Tuesday

De P'you, France, April 19.—(AP)—Former Marshall Henri Philippe Petain, stricken with pneumonia, was reported today to have passed away at his residence in Paris. Petain, who is 95 next Tuesday, suffered a second relapse yesterday. He had appeared to be recovering from his recent attack of pneumonia when he suffered the first setback five days ago. Petain's lawyers, who had planned to return to Paris, said they would remain here, indicating that the wartime chief of the Vichy government was not out of danger.
