Red Cross Drive Ends

Short of Quota; Activities Will Continue on Present Aid Level

The 1951 Fund Drive for the Manchester Red Cross has been concluded with total contributions of \$14,028.65. Fund Drive Chairman York Strangford reported to the Board of Directors at a meeting held last evening in the Red Cross office. This sum represents 88 per cent of the quota sought. It is the first time the quota has not been met since the chapter received its charter in 1917.

It is the intention of the Board of Directors, however, to carry on existing activities by exercising economy and economy, even though further expansion will not be possible this year.

Rare Swine Disease May Cause Loss Here

Veterinary authorities today expressed fear that a previously rare swine disease called infectious atrophic rhinitis may cause heavy losses to many farmers in 1951.

The American Foundation for the Prevention of Infectious Diseases reported today that the disease continues on the increase following serious outbreaks last year.

Infectious atrophic rhinitis does not kill many animals outright, the Foundation says, "but it may stop gains at the point where hog raising is no longer profitable. Affected pigs fail to put on weight.

"Increased baby pig sneeze frequency and their snouts later become plugged in or twisted due to shrinkage of the bones of the nose. Scour, unthriftiness and pneumonia may follow.

Jobless Claim Lists Growing

Rise Here Reflects Picture in Other Parts of State; Is Seasonal

Unemployment claims here rose 19.3 per cent last week when the total reached 213, including 127 females. There were 62 initial claims and 151 continued.

The rise was also noted throughout the state with female claims increasing. Seasonal layoffs in garment, hats and textiles were responsible for the increase. Women made up 59.8 per cent of the total initial claims also were up.

The field offices reported the following layoffs and part-time reductions due to lack of work: needle trades 875 and 220 on a part-time schedule; textile 490 and 25 part-time; hats 165 and 25 part-time; tobacco 100; carpet, 100; woollen 55; metal goods 35; wire lamp shade 20; and bearings 15.

Material shortages claimed the following layoffs: brass 100; all-weather 20; toys 20 and watches 20. Hinges and rollers were noted in garments, 80 and bearings 40.

Cancer Topic Of Talk Here

Dr. Edward White of Hartford Speaks Before the Rotary Club

Dr. Edward White physician on the staff of McCook and Newington Hospitals was the guest speaker at the meeting of the Rotary Club last evening. The topic of the speaker was "Cancer" and what is being done in research, money allocation and methods of treatment.

Speaking of the funds collected Dr. White explained that sixty per cent of the total goes to National Cancer Foundation and forty per cent remaining in Conn. and distributed to the towns according to donations received from that town.

At the clinic held every Wednesday at McCook hospital, average poor and rich alike will receive treatment and are taught the value of a complete physical examination. Doctors from all over the state are also told the necessary and thorough check-up on patients. The McCook Clinic is the only laboratory in the country to receive a National award that is not connected with a Medical College.

Cancer, the speaker stated has been known for five thousand years but not much has been done to find a cure until recently. Much of the lack of knowledge is laid upon the victim, who did not want to face the truth.

The disease itself in most cases is painless and subtle in its method, reaching proportionally close to the incurable stage before the patient realizes it especially of the growth is internal. Different symptoms was explained by Dr. White of both internal and external cases.

Cancer is treated two ways at present, by surgery and radiation and one or both methods are the only ones practical. Surgery has advanced to a point where doctors can do things never attempted before and is the better method of cure. X-rays is comparable to surgery in the amount of rays a man can tolerate.

Various discoveries and experiments are being tried out and have proven of great value, the speaker stated.

Dr. White spoke in a language especially apt for the layman, he spoke quietly and with authority on a subject of which he is an expert.

The members who wished to ask any questions were asked by Vice President Harry Macdonald in the main after the meeting.

Several other Rotarians were present and participated in the open forum.

The weekly prize donated by Salv Verdillo was won by John Alvord.



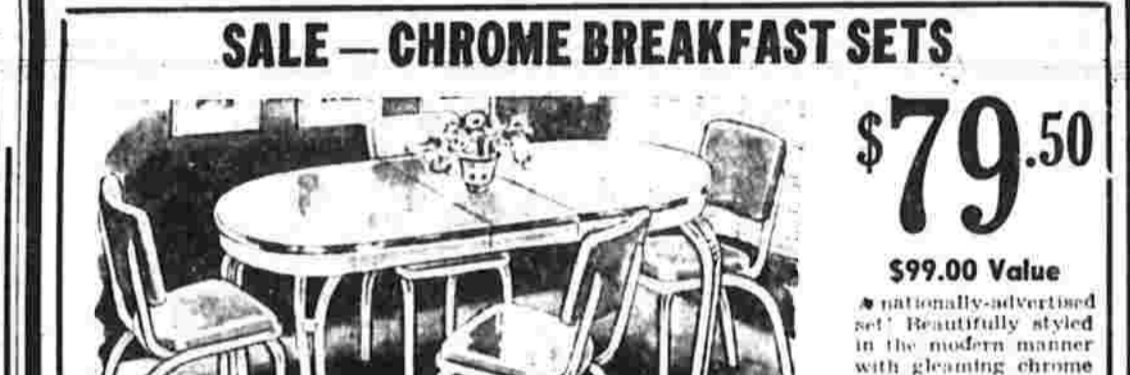

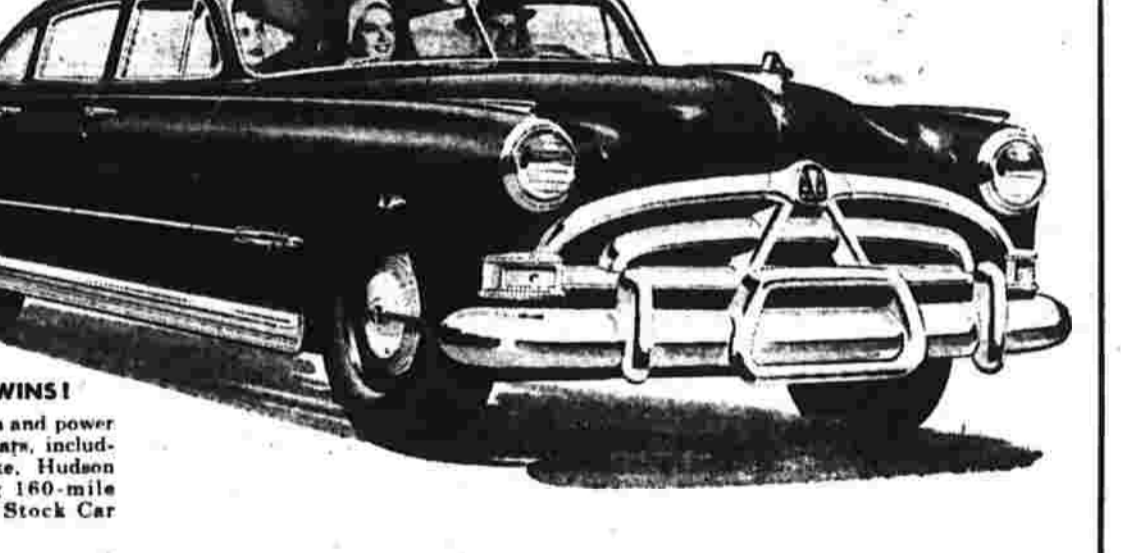
