cause many times more casualties than we have suffered in all the fighting in Korea.

"I do not want to be responsible for bombing that school."

Mr. Truman did not refer by name to MacArthur, who has advocated his action against Manchuria, a naval blockade and use of Chinese Nationalist troops on Formosa against the Chinese Reds.

Atom War At Stake

Supporters of MacArthur, mostly Republicans, plainly were the target of the criticism.

"We are right in the midst of a big debate on foreign policy. A lot of people are looking at this debate as if it were just a political fight. But the stakes are a lot higher."

Mr. Truman said.

"We do not intend to fall into that trap," Mr. Truman said.

"I do not propose to strip this country of the Allies in the face of Soviet danger."

On his side, the President took issue with MacArthur's views.

He declared that "the best collective military advice in this country" backs his policy of limiting the war to Korea, and that "our policy is designed to win."

MacArthur has said it will end in "bloody stalemate."

Mr. Truman left open the possibility that some of MacArthur's demands for harder blows against the Reds might be carried out, but he said that "if the aggressor takes further action which threatens the security of the United Nations in Korea, we will counter that action."

"There has been a long debate," Mr. Truman said.

**Chief Schoen Dies At 66 In Danbury**

**Oakland Span Is Inspected**

State Highway Engineer Looks Over The Local Bridge Today

Attorney Vincent McPadden and Mrs. Helen Fitzpatrick, acting as a committee of neighborhood petitioners, this morning met at the Oakland bridge with engineers of the State Highway Department to discuss possible reconstruction and widening of the bridge, site of many traffic accidents in the past.

The meeting this morning was the result of a petition, drafted by a large group in the neighborhood and submitted to State Highway Commissioner O. Albert Hill. The petition noted a dangerous narrowing of the bridge, traffic and pedestrian hazards and the long accident toll of past years.

The present structure is 19 feet 8 inches wide. It is proposed to make the bridge 28 feet wide. During the course of the conversation this morning, it was learned by the petitioners that Manchester has not had any new bridges built by the state in many years.

Following the discussion of the problem this morning, the highway engineers stated they would make his recommendations to the commissioner who would later communicate with the committee here on the subject.
